Community groups with plans to make a better place to live connected with agencies at an information session sponsored by the Halton Healthy Community Fund on Jan. 27 at the River Oaks Community Centre.

"Essentially we're all the same," noted Bob Dobson, regional program manager for the Ontario Trillium Foundation. "We all care about the same thing. We share the same vision," he said.

That vision would see collaborative partnerships develop between those with programs that address the 2005 theme of "strengthening communities through neighbourhood and/or families" and the Halton Healthy Community Fund's 13 partners.

The Ontario Trillium Foundation and the Community Foundation of Oakville are also providing grants for programs of a similar nature.

Projects that received funding through the Halton Healthy Community Fund last year include the First Mentors Program; a Big Brother project dealing with at risk Little Brothers; Choices for Positive Youth Relationships; and a program used in high school classrooms to help young people develop interpersonal skills.

This year's qualifying groups are eligible for grants of up to \$30,000 for one year.

"Every proposal is reviewed on its own merits," said Dobson.

Rusty Baillie, Chief Executive Officer of the Community Foundation of Oakville and a member of the funding opportunities committee, spoke briefly about the funding opportunities available through their respective organizations.

Baillie noted that his 10 year-old organization is somewhat akin to the United Way, although the group invests the money donated to them in order to get the returns to fund programs.

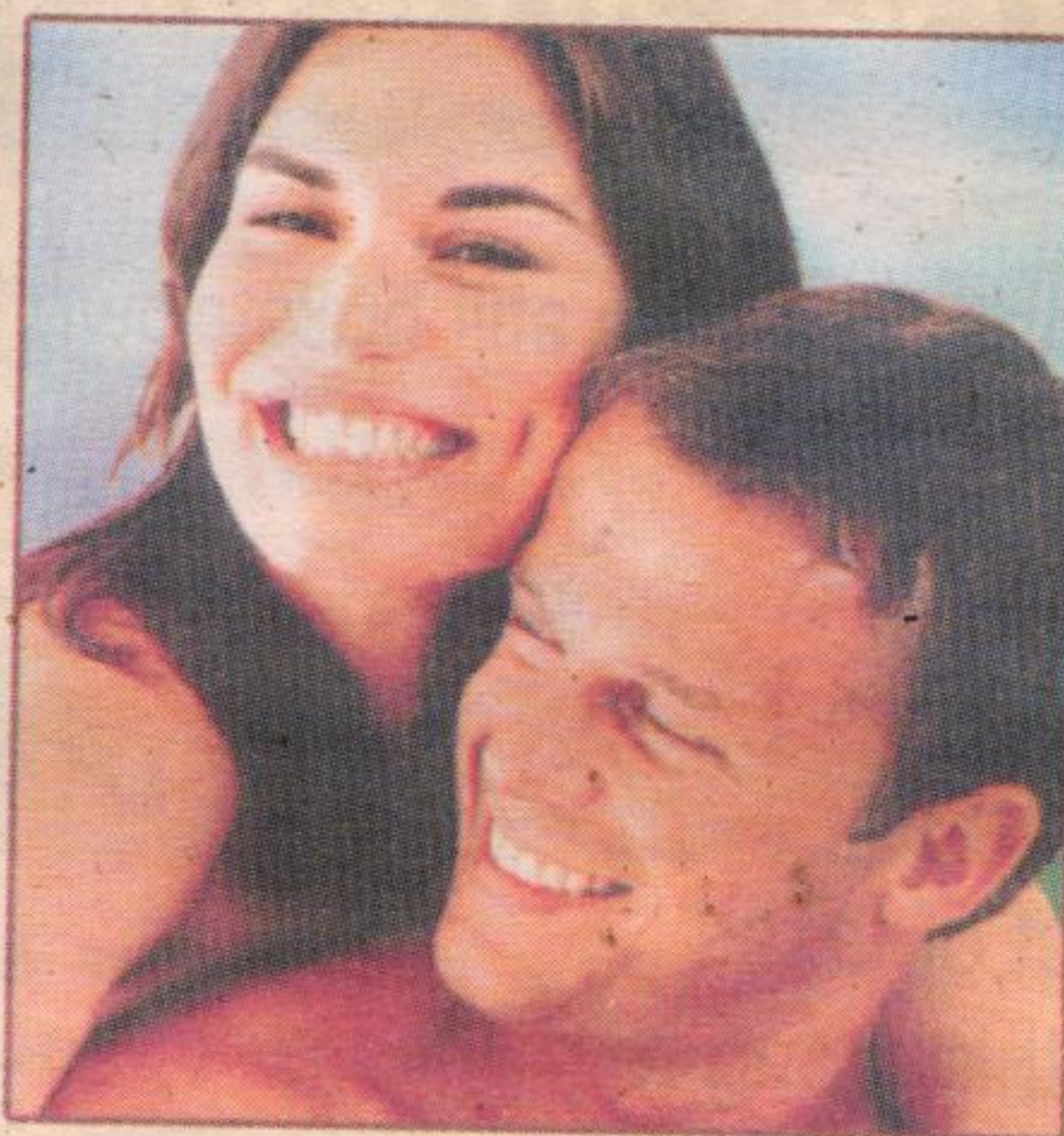
