ouncil is deep in budget discussions. We have had many meetings on this year's budget. This will be the first year that the Pavement Management Plan will be implemented. What is the Pavement Management Plan? This was supported last year at budget and something that I had campaigned on. This is where we increase your taxes by 2%. This 2% goes directly to resurfacing roads. Nothing else.

The Town is \$57 million dollars behind in repairing roads. You may ask "how in the world did this happen?" I will give you a quick history lesson on the Town of Halton Hills. Acton, Esquesing, and Georgetown were amalgamated in 1974 to become the

Town of Halton Hills.

The Province wanted to see this marriage work so they gave one dollar for every dollar the Town spent on roads. When I was first elected in 1982, the Province was already reviewing its contribution for every dollar the Town would spend on roads. By the early nineties, the Provincial Government of the day cancelled their contribution for roads, leaving the municipality to pay 100% of all road repairs. The Province continues today to pay 90% of construction costs only on those portions of Highway 7 in the urban areas.

To reconstruct one kilometer of road is a cost of approximately \$1.5 million dollars. Now you get the picture. It doesn't take long to be \$57 million dollars behind in roads.

As I write this, I do not know where we will be in the budget, but whatever the outcome, you can be sure that 2% of a tax increase will go directly to our roads to make them safer for our community.


