

## Georgetown Fire department opens information kiosk

Residents of Georgetown, along with their regular shopping at Georgetown Market Place, will now be able to add fire safety information to their baskets by stopping at the new kiosk located just inside the entrance doors beside Loblaws.

"The information centre is another tool to assist in the delivery of fire safety messages to the citizens of our community," says Director of Fire Services Bob Mead.

The new information centre replaces the former one shared with Halton Regional Police Services and will offer in-person knowledge and expertise from Fire Prevention Staff.

The centre has been made possible by the generosity of Ridgeway Services owner Tony Sheppard, who offered to replace the old kiosk when the opportunity arose for the fire department to take sole ownership, and also through the efforts of Georgetown Market Place and The Sign Shoppe.

A schedule outlining times that fire prevention staff will be on hand will be posted and customers will also hear of the schedule through the mall's public service announcements.
