Alliso has dreams to travel to Kenya with a group called Leaders Today, a non-profit volur teer organization of young people who are determined to stand up and make changes in the world. Her parents are supportive of her quest to help others off on the other side of the world but remain a little shocked at their daughter's decision. "My father kind of flipped when


