ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING OF BRONTE ROAD (REGIONAL ROAD 25) FROM UPPER MIDDLE ROAD (REGIONAL ROAD 38) TO HIGHWAY 407 AND DUNDAS STREET (REGIONAL ROAD 5) AT BRONTE ROAD (REGIONAL ROAD 25) IN THE TOWN OF OAKVILLE

The Region of Halton will be widening and realigning Bronte Road (Regional Road 25) from Upper Middle Road (Regional Road 38) to Highway 407 from a 2-lane rural road to a 4-lane urban road. Included in the works are the widening of approximately 900 m of Dundas Street (Regional Road 5) from a 4 to 6-lane road east and west of the realigned Bronte Road intersection and the installation of a 1200 mm diameter watermain on Bronte Road (Regional Road 25), from Westoak Trails Boulevard to Dundas Street (Regional Road 5) and on Dundas Street (Regional Road 5) to approximately 400 m easterly.

A Public Information Centre will be held to provide you with an opportunity to review the project drawings and to discuss any potential construction disruptions resulting from the proposed works. Representatives from both Halton Region and our consultants, SNC Lavalin Engineering & Consultants Inc., will be in attendance to answer any questions. 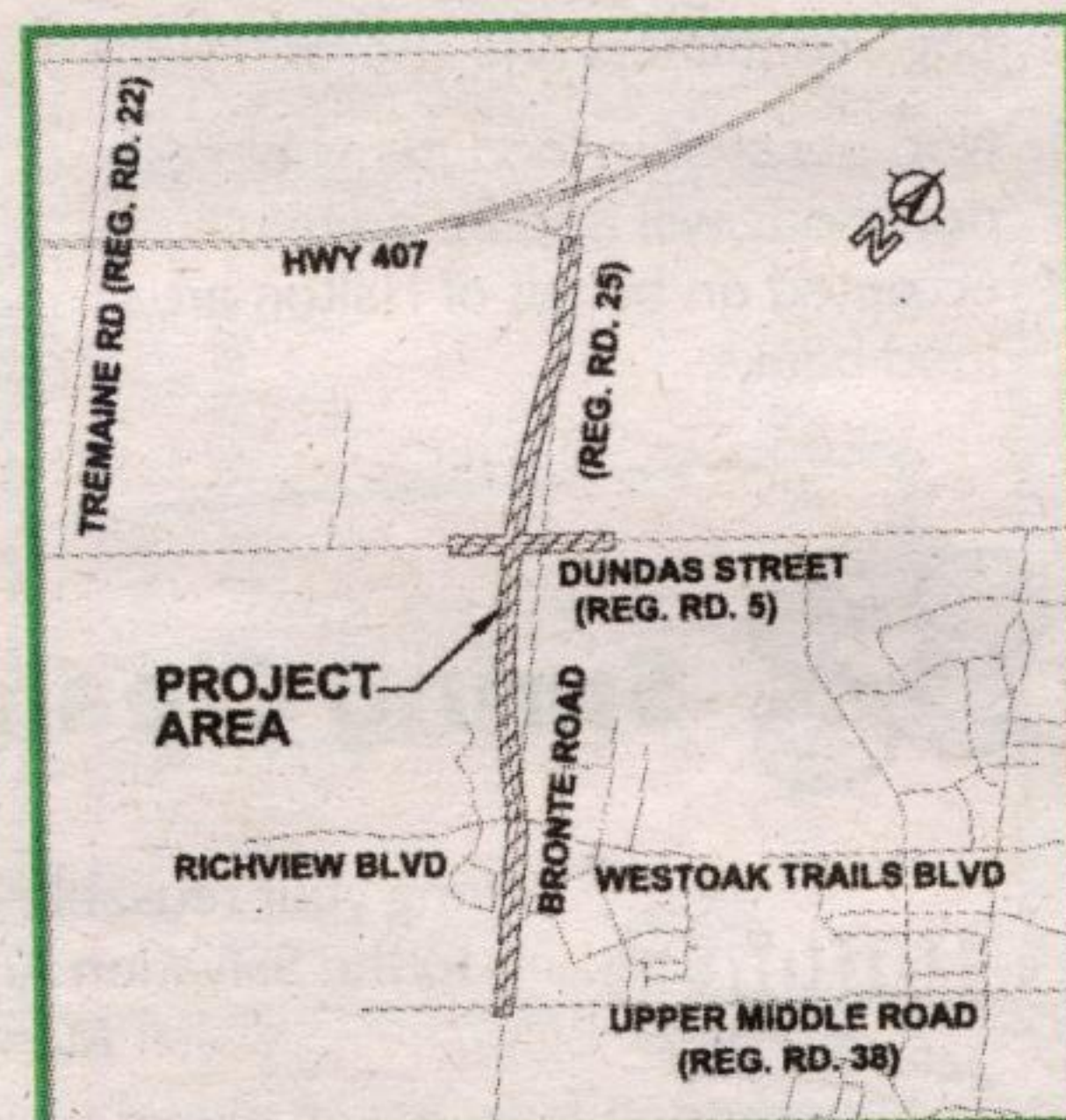
