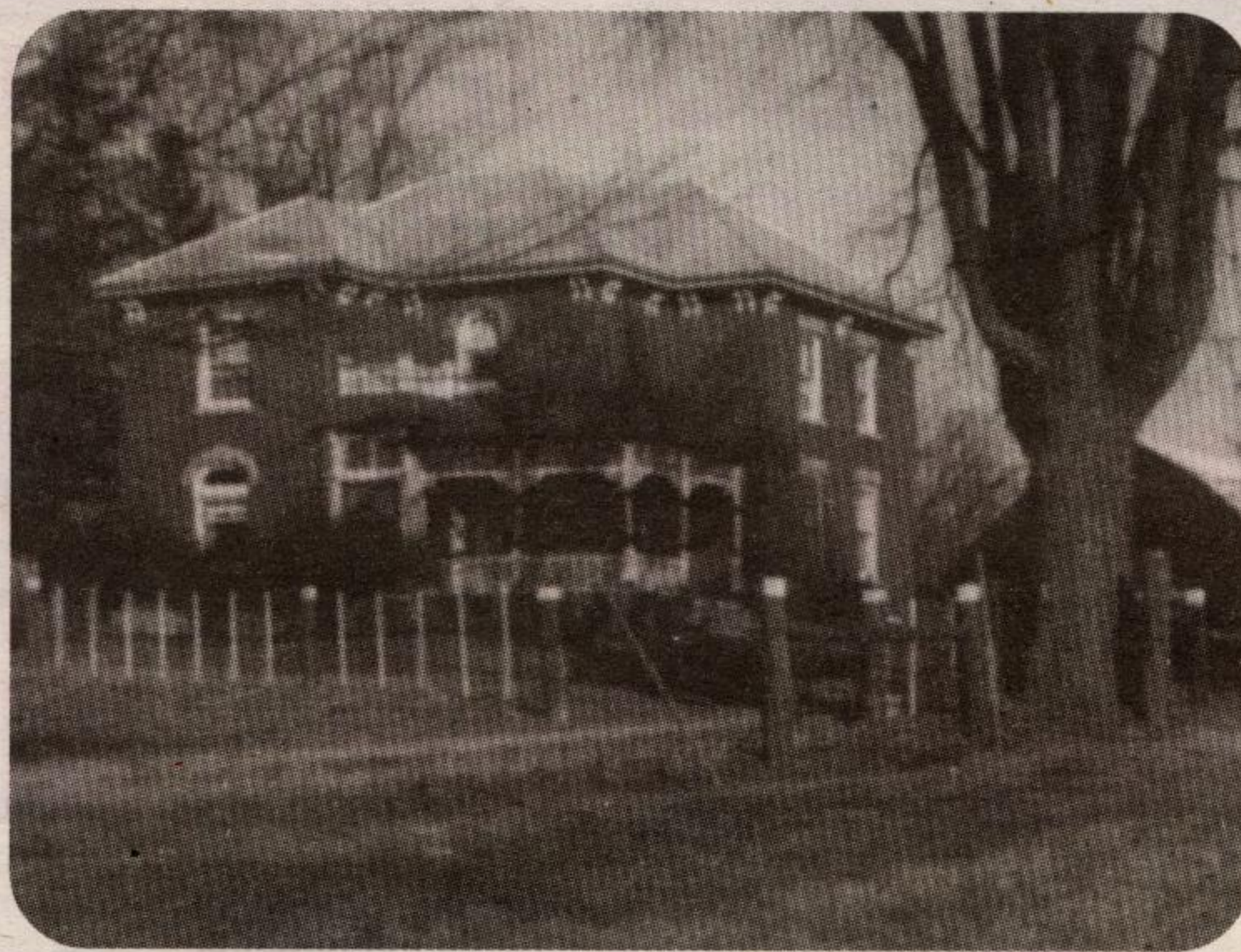


# DOX memories

LOT 10 CONC. 8 ESQUESING

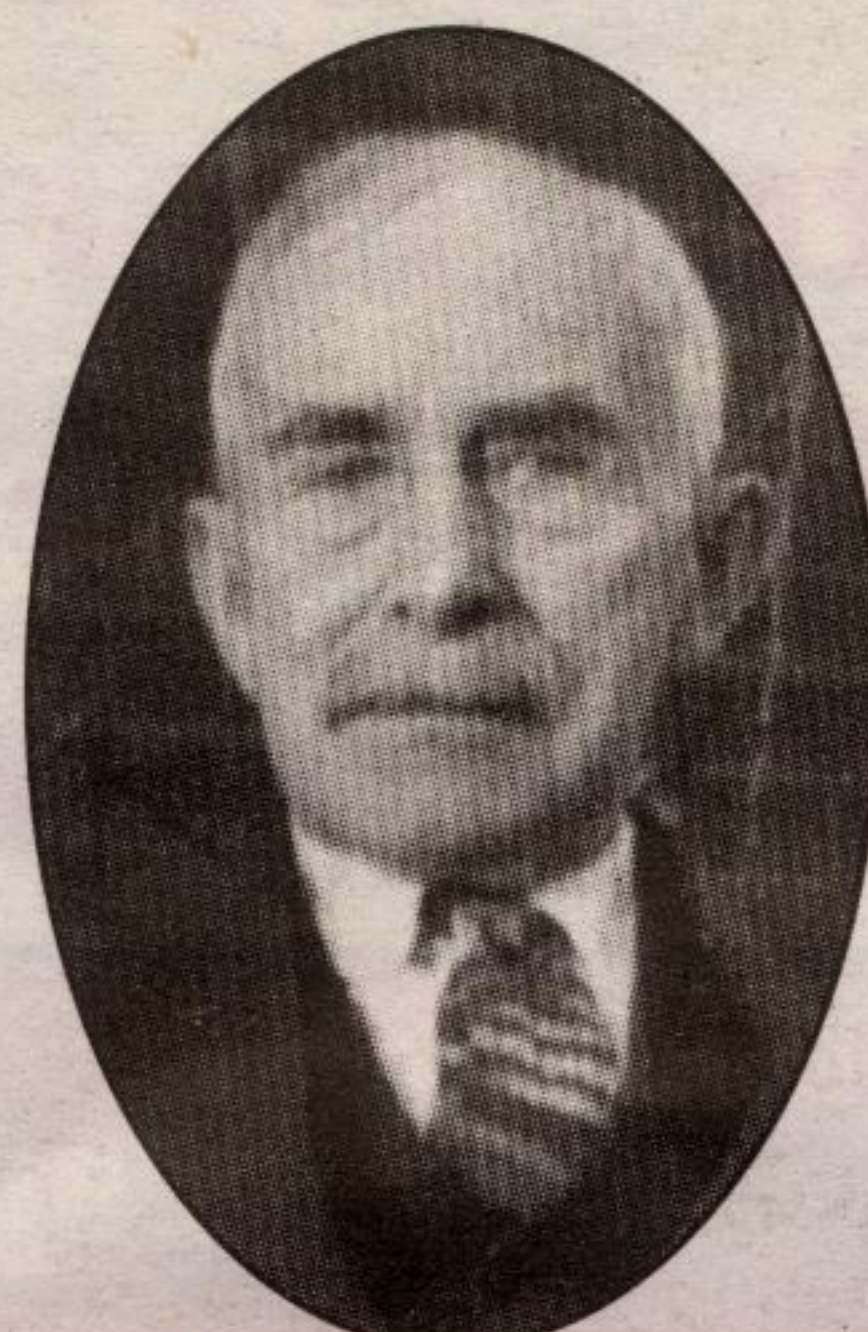
**Homestead

They farm on lot 9 on the 6th line. Bernice was an assistant organist at Ashgrove Church at one point. She married first, Fred Williamson, second Dr. Wesley Williams. They live in Burleson Texas. Melford Guy Wilson married Jennie McMeekin of Norval. They farmed at lot 7 Con.10, 10th line. They were involved in the United Church and community in Norval. Their son Earl married Anne Chalker and continued to farm. Their son David is a dairy farmer there now. Ruth Wilson married Harry Moore. They farm near Guelph. After Jennie's death Guy married Eunice Thompson Moore. Arthur married first Mary Andrews. He was a dentist in Woodstock, Ontario and then in New Glasgow, Nova Scotia. They had a son, Robert. Later he married Donelda Hayman. They had a daughter Charlotte.. Frank married Marjorie Blake. They farmed the home farm. They had one daughter Marilyn. She married Graham Reeve and live in Kentville Nova Scotia Graham works in Real Estate and she teaches school. Marjorie was assistant organist at Ashgrove United Church and pianist at community occasions. John and Hannah's second son Henry and his wife Ida Tansley farmed the north half of lot 10. Ida was quite involved in Women's Institute and Ashgrove Church. On July 11, 1918 the first United Farmer's Women's Organization of Ontario was started at her home. It spread across the province for several years. Henry and Ida had a daughter, Leona who married Sydney Breckon. He taught school, becoming principal at Norwood. Their son John Guy worked at P.L. Robertson plant in Milton, then operated his own electrical repair shop at Ashgrove. He married Edith Hayward of Trafalgar Township. They lived in the north corner house that had been the Post Office. Edith had a beautiful soprano voice. Guy and Edith moved to Bancroft, their son Harold lives there now. Walter lives north of Rockwood. Myrna married Forest Lee. They live in 'Porta Varl. Ida's nephew Eaton Tansley lived with them for a time and was well known in the community.

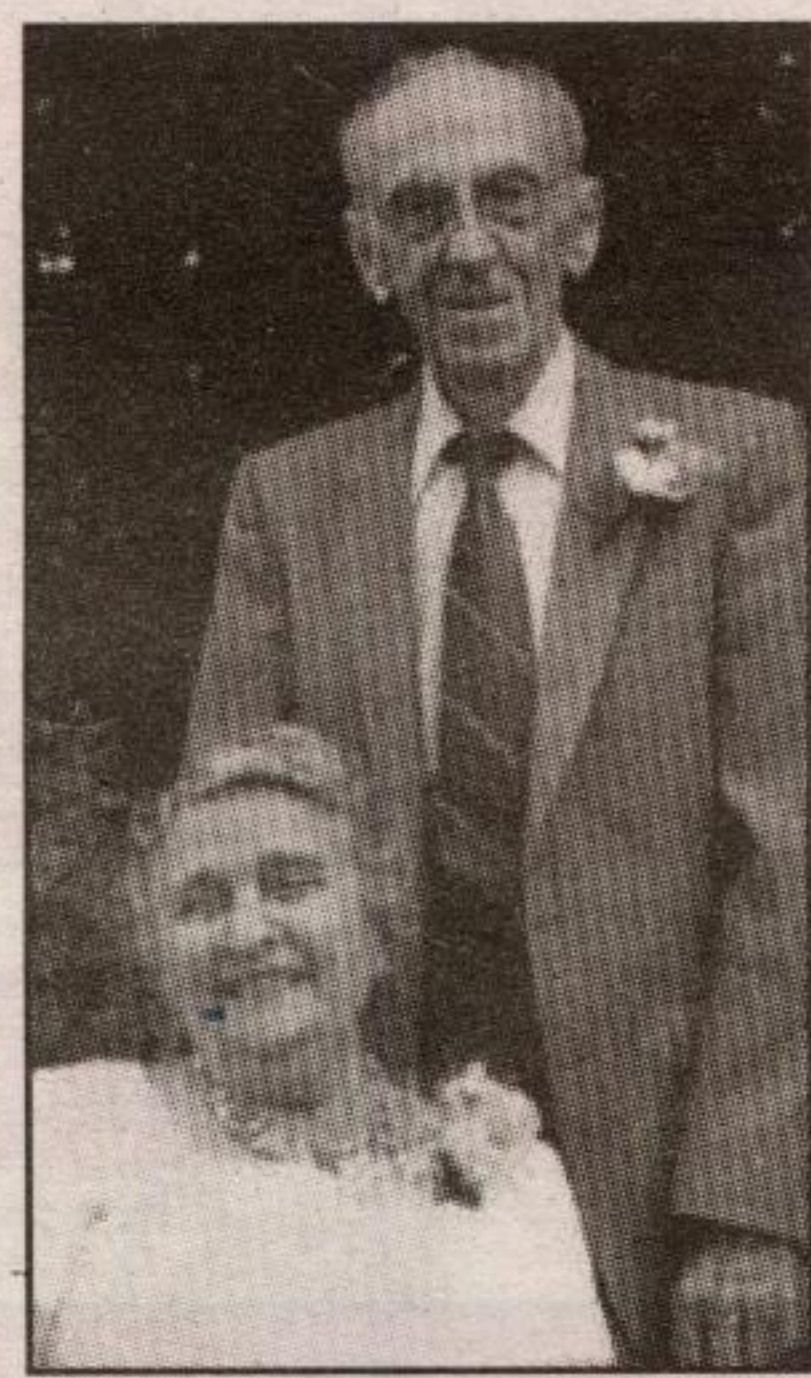
