

# Children's art section at Arts Milton Festival

The first annual Arts Milton Festival promises to provide fun for the entire family. To be held on May 28 at the Milton Fairgrounds, the festival will offer performances throughout the day from local dance groups, music bands and theatre groups, as well as offering a peek into the Fine Arts community, where local artists will share display their handiwork and demonstrate their techniques.

For the young at heart, Tiny Tim Development School will be hosting a children's art section, where children aged 2 to teen can participate in a wide array of crafts and activities.

Projects will include a wall mural of paintings; play-dough activities, face painting and various age appropriate craft projects, including the making of masks, finger puppets, woven bookmarks, stationary pads and more.

"Tiny Tim has been really great about donating their time and they're really looking forward to it," says Children's Event Coordinator Dr. Natalie McDonald. "It should be interesting to get the children involved creatively in the Festival as well."

All activities at the Children's Craft Area will be free of charge from noon until 4 pm. Parents are asked to remain at the Craft Area with their children and Tiny Tim Development will be setting up shop in an outdoor location if the weather permits, so please remember the sunscreen. If the weather is prohibitive, the Craft Area will be set up under the Grandstand.

The Arts Milton Festival is available to everyone throughout the day free of charge, although voluntary donations to Arts Milton will be gratefully accepted. Tickets are now available for the Grandstand Show later that evening, which will feature local band Life Time Drive (LTD) and award winning Elvis tribute artist Steve Kabakos. Tickets are \$25 and are available at the Dorland-Haight Galleries in Milton.

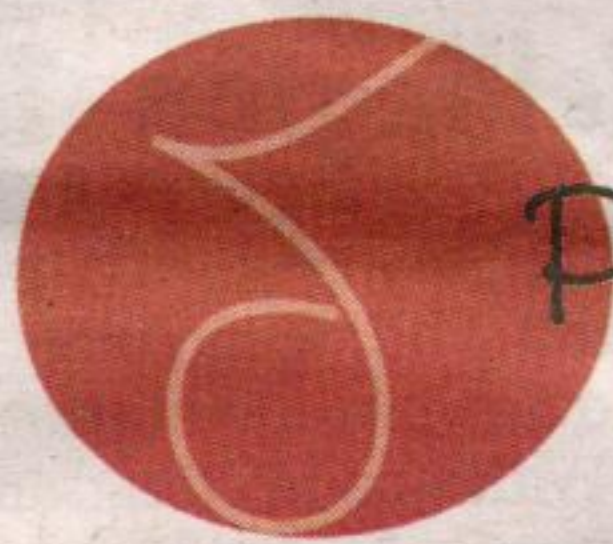
