Habitat for Humanity build began Saturday in Rockwood

A fter much preparation, the Lizzotte and Paton families of Wellington County saw construction begin on their new homes.

The two partner families took part in a Blessing of the Foundations ceremony held to kick off Habitat for Humanity Wellington County's latest build, a project to construct two semi-detached homes on Inkerman Street in Rockwood.

The build will provide homes for Robyn Lizzotte and her children Tyler, 7, and 4year-old Paige as well as Sheila Paton and her daughters, 3-year-old Mackenzie and

Alexa, 16 months.

Both the Lizzottes and Patons live outside the Rockwood area, but they're looking forward to becoming part of the community. And Lizzotte says she's excited about the prospect of helping out with the construction. She says this will give her the opportunity to learn about housing construction from the ground up.

Over the summer, volunteers will build the two homes on land adjacent to the Habitat homes built in 2001.

The two-storey homes will be approximately 1,100 square feet and they'll include a walkout basement, three bedrooms, a bathroom as well as a dining and living room area.

Clare Irwin, co-chair of Habitat for Humanity Wellington County's public relations committee, says volunteers are still needed for the build, especially trades people and anyone with construction experience. Volunteer application forms are available at website Habitat's


