## Milton Legion completes renovations

Ed Goodall moves past faded photographs, dusty old bayonets, and yellowed news clippings. The Milton Legion War Memorabilia Room is a collection of personal items used by the men and women who served in over a hundred years of war. The unique aspect is most of the items came from soldiers who lived in the Halton area. It is astonishing that a small community could have produced such a collection. The room is undergoing major renovations for a grand opening this November.

Ten years ago, the Legion first opened their museum to cadets and school groups. "This used to be the seniors centre and the women used to do their exercises on this floor," Mr. Goodall said. "When the new seniors' centre was built, we advertised the fact that we wanted to create this museum and every piece here has been donated from people all over Halton." Some of the items in the museum are unique. Ed Goodall shows a bayonet used in the Boer war (1899-1902). "You can take it out of the scabbard and it is still sharp, just as the first day it was made," Mr. Goodall points out. Items

include service uniforms donated by Legion members, photographs, radio equipment, books and actual weapons used during WWI and WWII. There is even a special corner of the room dedicated to Milton's own Astronaut, Chris Hadfield.

"After our renovations are completed this month we will be hiring a curator to catalogue the documents and artefacts," Mr. Goodall stated. "Hopefully this will be completed in time for the unveiling of the museum on Remembrance Day."

The first step in the renovation was to install a new service elevator and a wheelchair ramp so the Legion could be more accessible. Construction started in May of 2005 and is almost near completion. The new renovations will make the museum accessible to aging veterans and provide safer wheelchair access to the hall. Thanks to a grant from the Trillium fund, the needed renovations to the Legion could be constructed this year.

Currently, the museum is closed for reconstruction and can only be visited through contact with the Milton Legion.

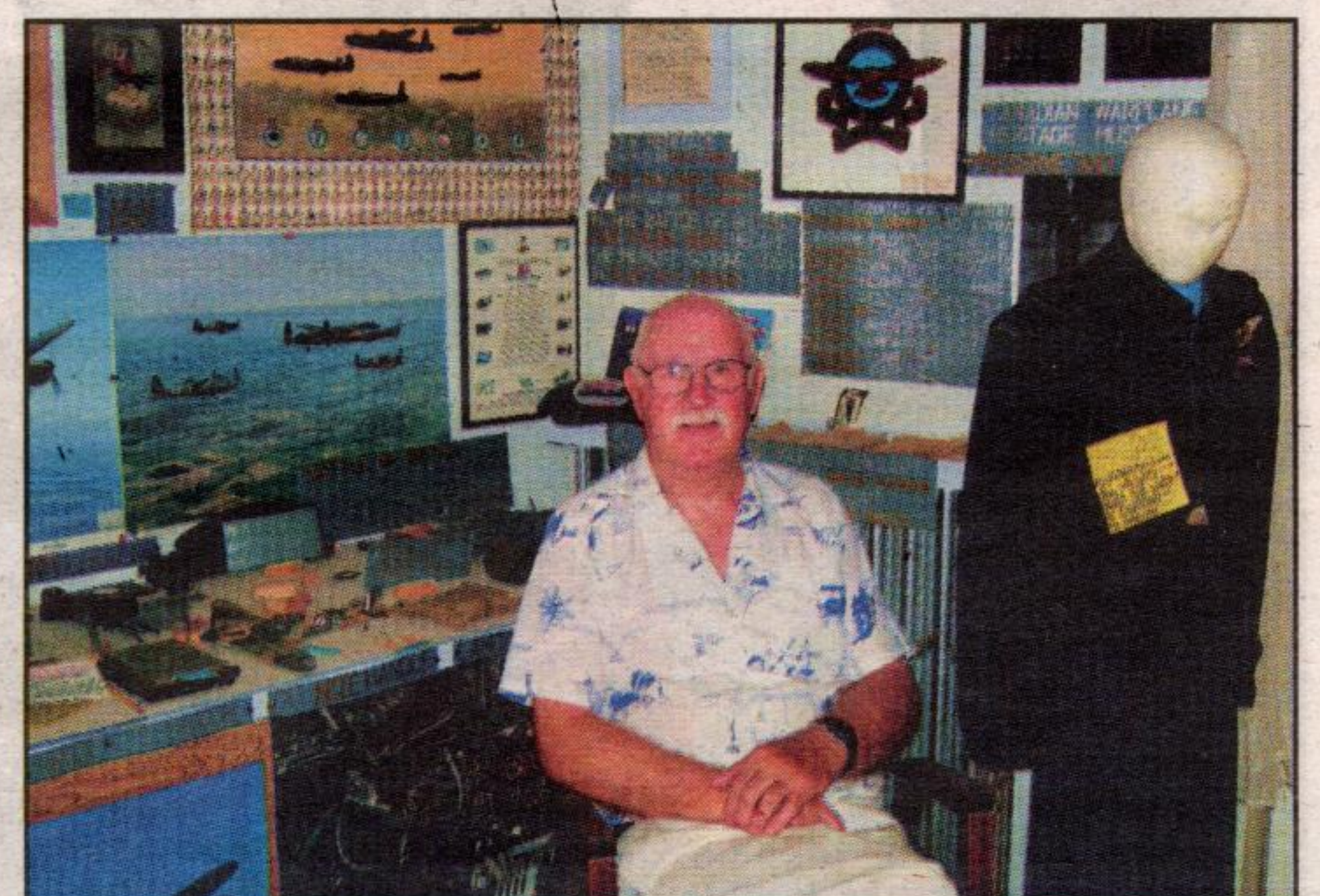
