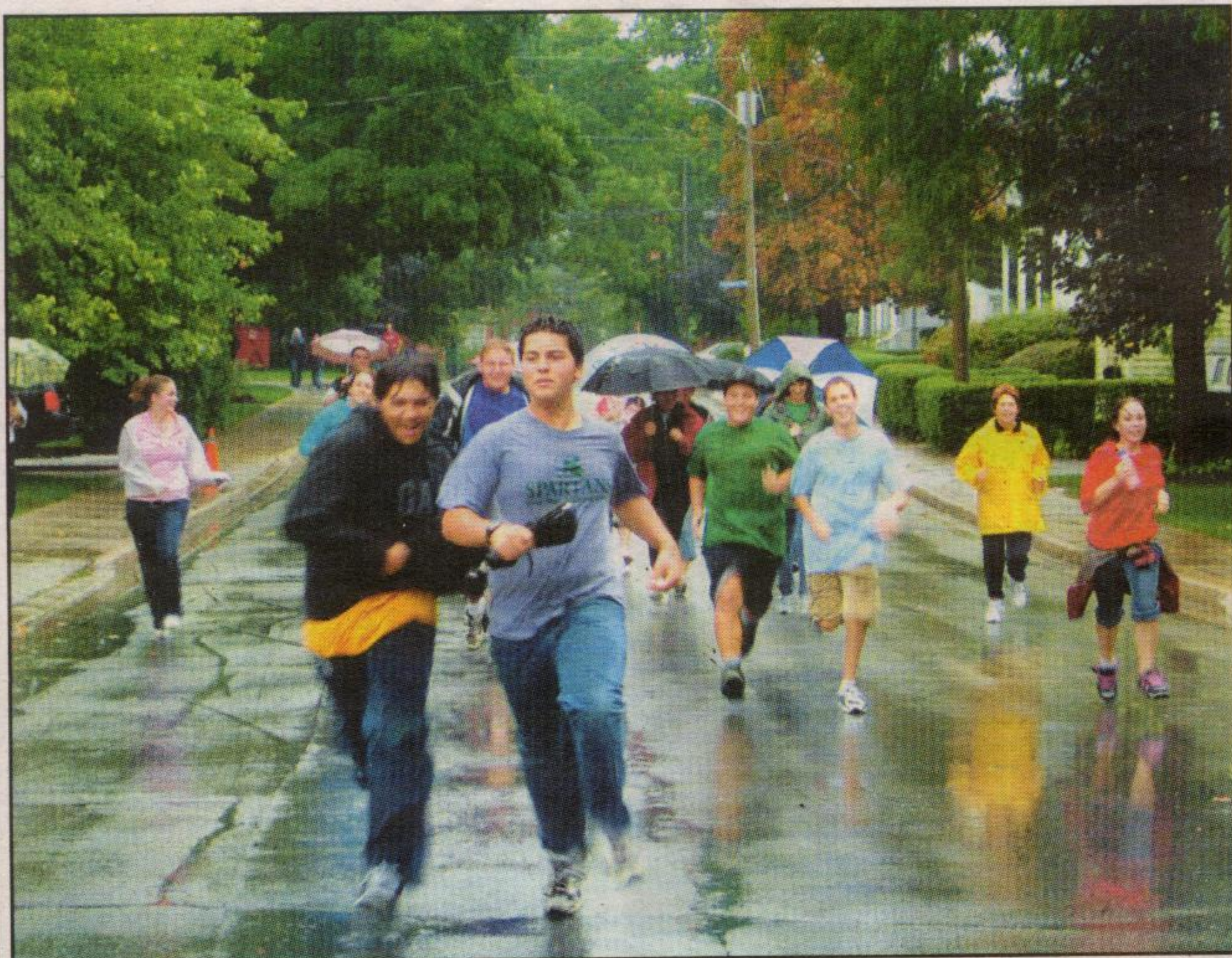


Terry Fox Run at E.C. Drury High School

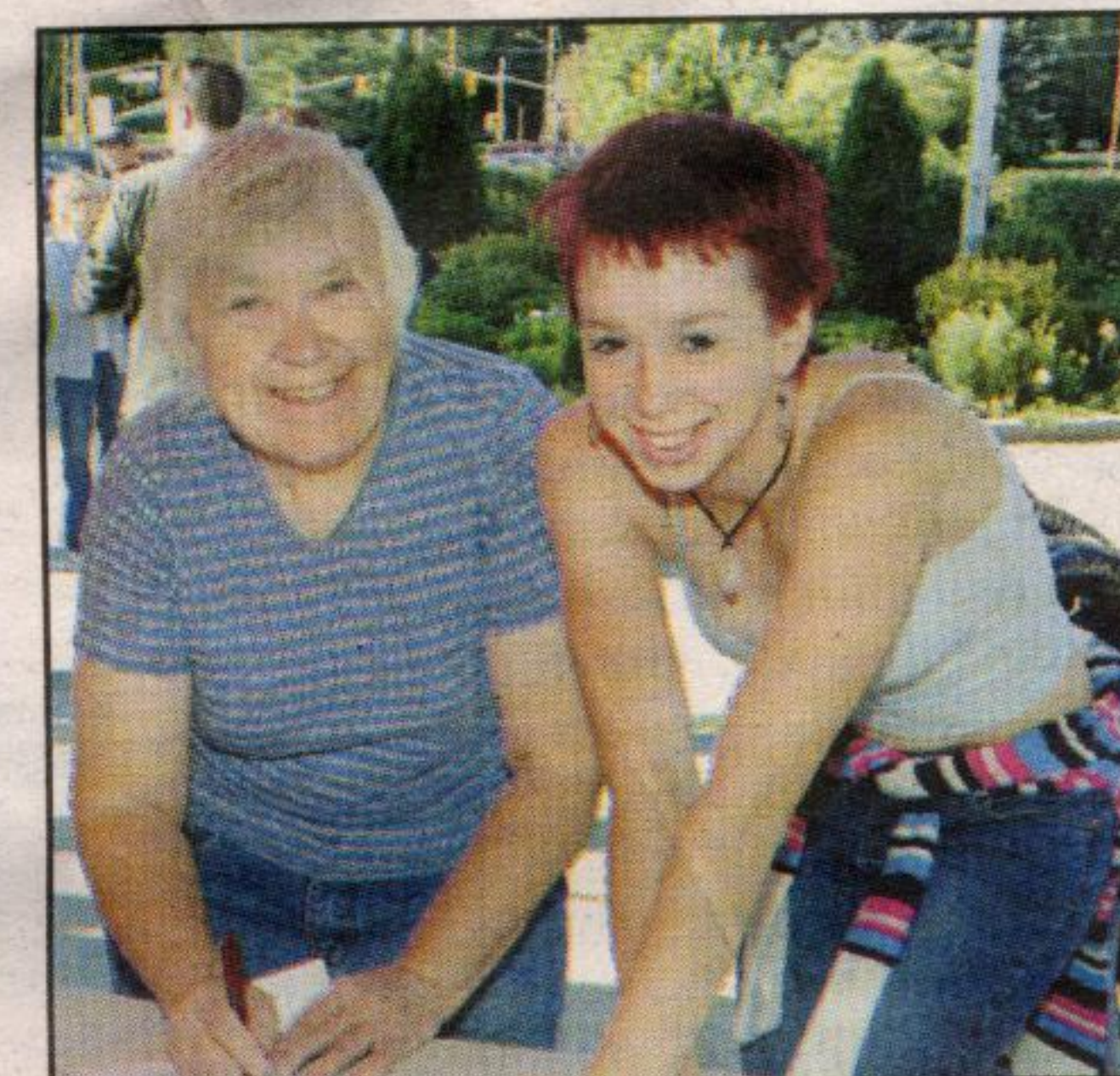
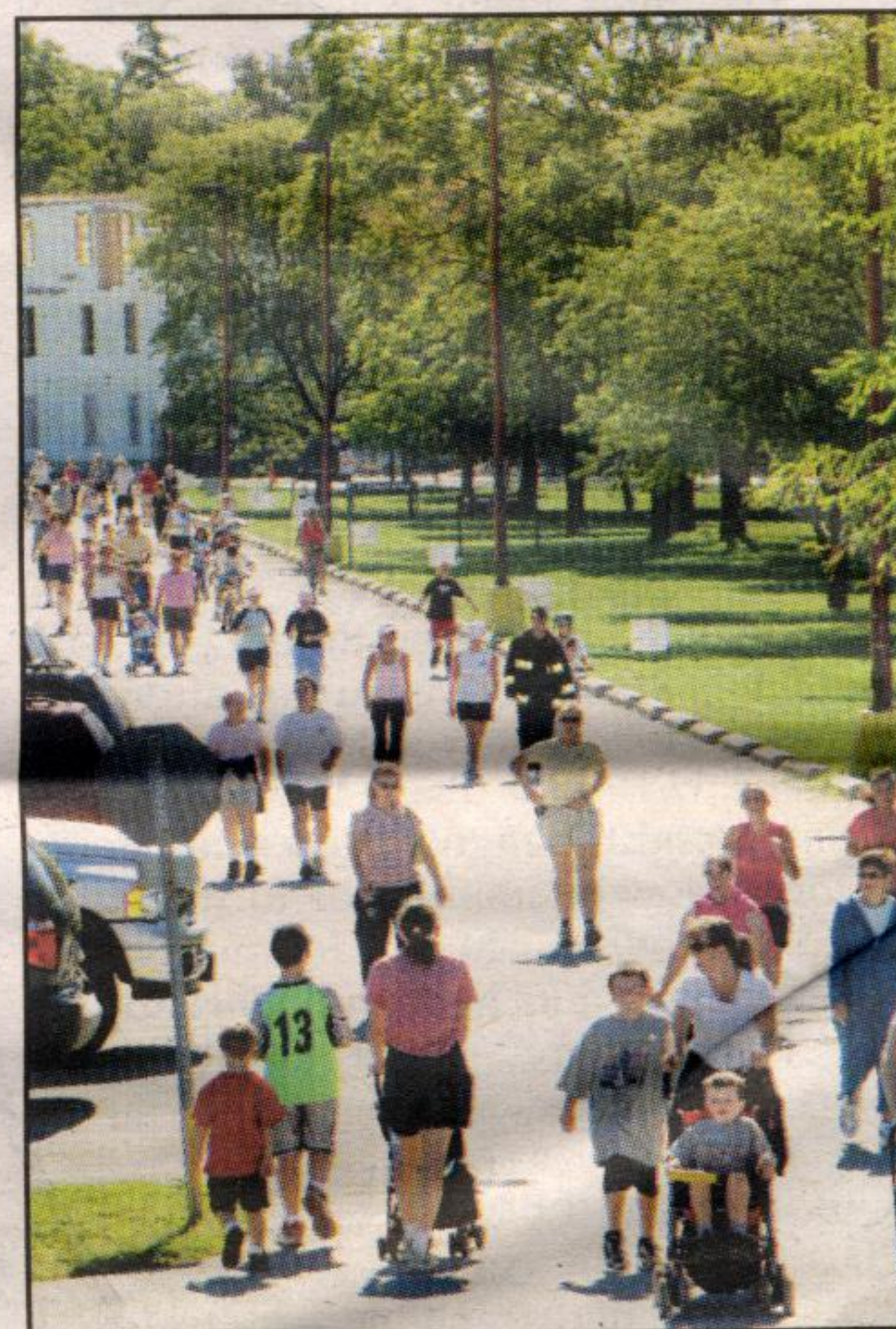
