






Milton Urban **Bulk Collection**



Place items at curb by 7:00 a.m. on your designated bulk collection day. Check the map for your corresponding collection zone. Items will be collected on the day designated for your zone.



If you have unwanted items that are in good condition, consider donating them to a charitable organization or reuse centre. You will be diverting material away from Halton's landfill and helping people in need at the same time!



Metal and Appliance Call-in Collection Service

Metal items and appliances will ONLY be collected on a call-in basis, and therefore will not be collected on your scheduled Bulk Collection day.

To receive collection, please call Halton Region at 1-866-4HALTON(1-866-442-5866).

Metal items and appliances include refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, stoves, washers, dryers, metal furniture, broken down swing sets, etc.



Yard Waste Collection Tips



Acceptable Items include:


Yard and garden trimmings, leaves, pumpkins, fallen fruit and tree and brush trimmings

Unacceptable Items include:

Grass clippings, tree stumps, sod, soil and rocks, garbage and recyclable material

Tips for setting out your yard waste:

- · Use open, reusable, rigid containers such as bushel basket or plastic tub
- · Place a yard waste sticker on your container (available from Halton Region)
- Use a paper yard waste bag
- Bags, containers must be less than 23 kg (50 lbs)



Note: Yard waste placed out in plastic bags (including decorative plastic Halloween bags) and cardboard boxes will not be collected.



Brush:

Must be tied in bundles no larger than 1.2 m (4 ft) long by 0.6 m (2 ft) wide, with branches a maximum of 7.5 cm (3 ") in diameter.
