Tax meeting postponed - Arena's grand opening MPP a no-show

A Town meeting designed to whip up public opposition to Provincial down loading plans has been postponed because the intended hot seat guest — Halton North MPP Ted Chudleigh — says it's premature. The meeting to outline the impact of Queen's Park's plans to transfer financial responsibilities to municipalities — generally known as the "Who Does What" (WDW) initiatives was scheduled for February 16, but at Monday night's general committee meeting Mayor Marilyn Serjeantson informed councillors that Chudleigh had indicated that "he really doesn't want to attend that meeting."

"If we're trying to whip up public input, and this room (Council Chambers) is limited in the number of the public that can be here, are we going to get real feel for what the public wants?" Elliott asked, suggesting that meetings be held in the high schools in Acton and Georgetown.

Town Acting Administrator Janet Lunn Stewart said that the intent of the proposed meeting was to enhance public awareness of the actual implications of the Provincial down loading.

"The \$64,000 question really is just that. What are the final and definite implications?" Lunn Stewart said.

Town Treasurer Andy Koopmans had warned not to expect new information before the March 31 date.



Koopmans queried, adding that they need to get on with their budget process even though they don't have firm numbers.


