



QUESTION: Spring is here. Is there anything special that I should do to my car so it is ready for summer?

ANSWER: The 1st area of concern is the cooling system. Anti-freeze should be changed at least once every 4 years or 80,000 km. Make sure there is no leaves or debris blocking the radiator. Belts and hoses should be free of bulges and cracks.

Thorough washing of all the surfaces (including the underbody) should be done to remove road salt and sand.

Oil changes, tire rotations and other maintenance items should be performed as required throughout the year.


