

tech talk

You may be over-inflated!

with

The Tech Talkers have noticed recently many people are driving vehicles with over-inflated tires. Tires that are over-inflated cost the vehicle owner money. Over-inflation can cause premature tire wear and lower fuel economy. It is also a major factor in ride stability and ride quality.

The inflation specification that is stamped on the side of the tire is a *guideline* for the maximum allowable tire pressure. The actual driving pressure recommended by the vehicle manufacturer may vary considerably from the number stamped on the side of the tire. For example, a 1993 Ford Probe G.T. tire reads maximum 45 p.s.i.

The tire settings should be 32 p.s.i. in the front and 26 p.s.i. in the rear. You should be able to locate a decal somewhere in the car or information in the owner's manual stating the correct tire pressure for your vehicle.

Don't make the mistake of filling the tire until it looks right. It's *important* to use a reliable tire pressure gauge when filling your tires and to check the pressure when the tires are cool to the touch. Tire pressure should be checked regularly; we suggest every few weeks.
