Is it time for a new belt?

QUESTION: I drive a 1995 neon with a 2.0 litre engine and a standard transmission. My maintenance schedule recommends that I replace the timing belt with my next service, which will be 85,000 kilometres.


Could you tell me if this is necessary and if the timing belt was to fail, would it hurt

the engine?

ANSWER: According to the shop manual, your timing belt should be changed

160,000 kilometres or 6 years, whichever should occur first.

You may be following a maintenance schedule created by the car dealer. This generic schedule covers a vast number of car lines. The Laser and Talon with Mitsubishi engines require timing belt replacement at 80,000 kilometres. Check in the maintenance section of the Chrysler Owners Manual that came with your car for your specific engine.

Council worries about high fees

Increases in development application fees in Halton Hills will be capped at 100 per cent as politicians try to cushion a hike in the price of doing business with the Town.

Without the cap some fees would have increased by as much as 254 per cent.

Town staff claim the fees are fair and expect few, if any, complaints from local developers, but some councillors, including Acton's Norm Elliott, worried the increases could make Halton Hills unattractive to developers.

"Not only are we charging more than anyone else in the area...the philosophy of 100 per cent (cost) recovery wasn't something that necessarily has to be done in every case," Elliott said at last week's general committee meeting

One fee that worried several councillors was the Town's charge of \$1,535 to process a minor site plan. Milton charges \$200 and Burlington charges \$680 for the same processing.

Only the Town's Building Department recovers its operating costs through building fees while some Recreation and Parks programs operate on a full cost recovery basis and show a profit.

When several councillors suggested that the development fee increases could be capped or phased in, Elliott argued for a deferral of the issue.

"I think that some of the increases are extreme and some of them we would be charging the highest rates in all of Halton Region and in one specific instance five or six times more for a minor site plan application," Elliott said.

Although general committee members voted to bring the issue back on May 25, on Monday night council approved the 100 per cent cap on fee increases.
