## Don't give me any static!

On a nice day getting in and out of a car can be a shocking experience, literally. Not to worry, there isn't anything electrically wrong with your car. Sliding across the seat of your car is just like dragging your feet on the carpet in your house. You generate a static charge. Humidity is a big factor in how high the static charge can get as the chart shows:

Activity	Relative Humidity	
	Low (10-20%)	High (65-90%)
	Volts	Volts
Walking across carpet	35,000	1,500
Walking over vinyl floor	12,000	250
Sliding across vehicle seat	25,000	1,000

You usually don't feel a shock until it gets over 3,000 volts. A way we have found to reduce this problem is to spray the interior of your car with "Static Guard." This is found in most grocery and department stores in the cleaning department with the laundry products.
