


SHEEHY: Edward Joseph

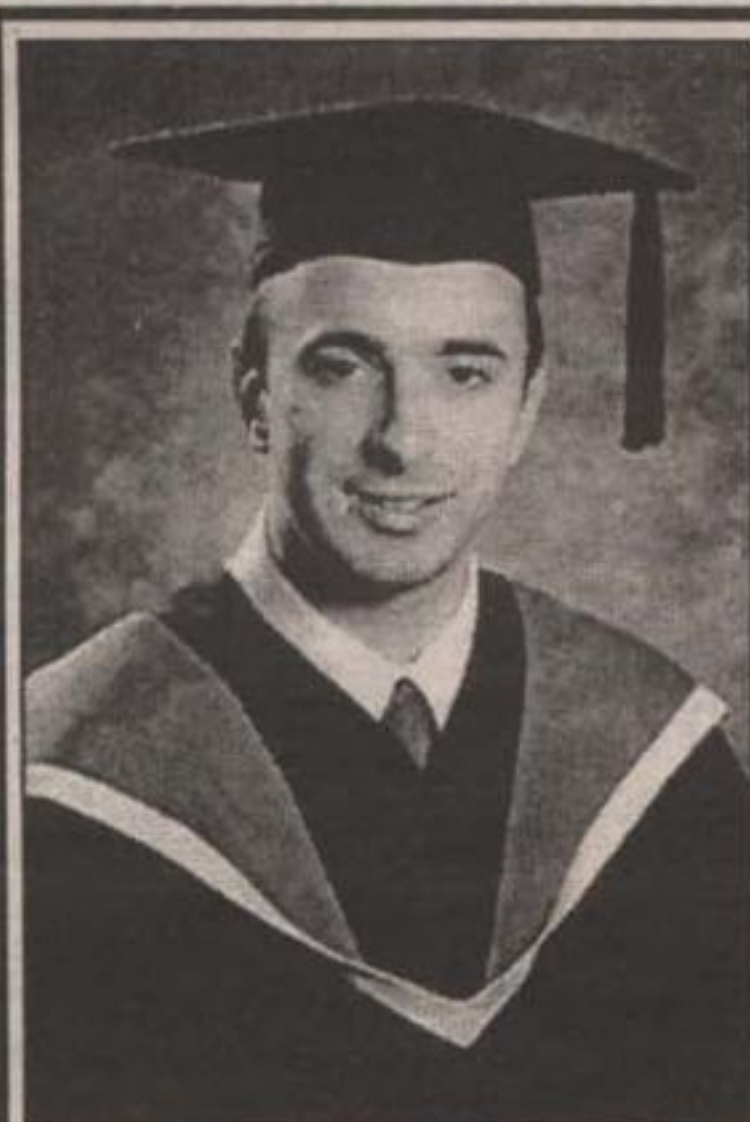
