Entrance at the gates costs approximately \$3.75 per adult, \$2.25 per child, and \$2.75 per student. Included in this price is the beach, hiking and mountain biking trails, as well as admission to the "Halton region Museum" which houses a fascinating display of local history. Special exhibits right now include "Toys and their Meaning" (only until this Saturday, sorry!) and, starting Sunday, an exhibit about the Victorians and their attitude towards nature.

The museum is open from noon until five and is definitely worth the visit if you will be in the area. Feel free to take along a picnic lunch as there are plenty of nice sites with tables where you can eat while enjoying the scenery.

If you haven't noticed, I enjoy trails, and Kelso has access to several that can take you up and along the Niagara Escarpment and are designed with mountain biking in mind! Whether walking or riding, there is definitely some nice scenery to be viewed from up there.


