Our newsletters are now ready and can be picked up at the Centre between 9 - 4 Monday to Friday.



dential street. Anne Bloye General Meeting - Please come out as your input is valuable.


Sept. 19 - Fall Fair Breakfast from 7 to 11 a.m. "Bet You Can't Eat It All".


