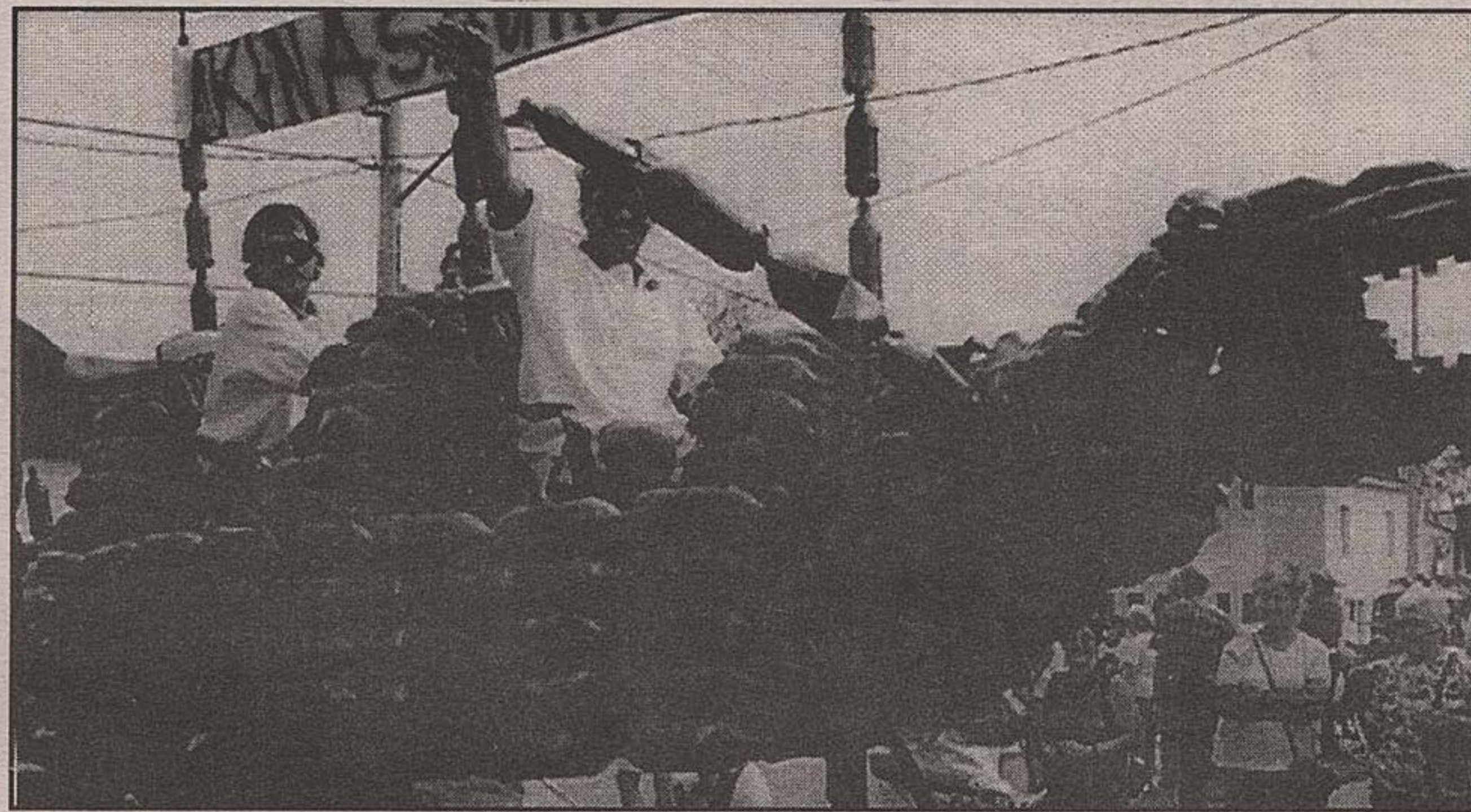

Oct. 15. The price includes a visit to St. Jacob's Market and Outlet Mall, lunch and a show at the Transylvania

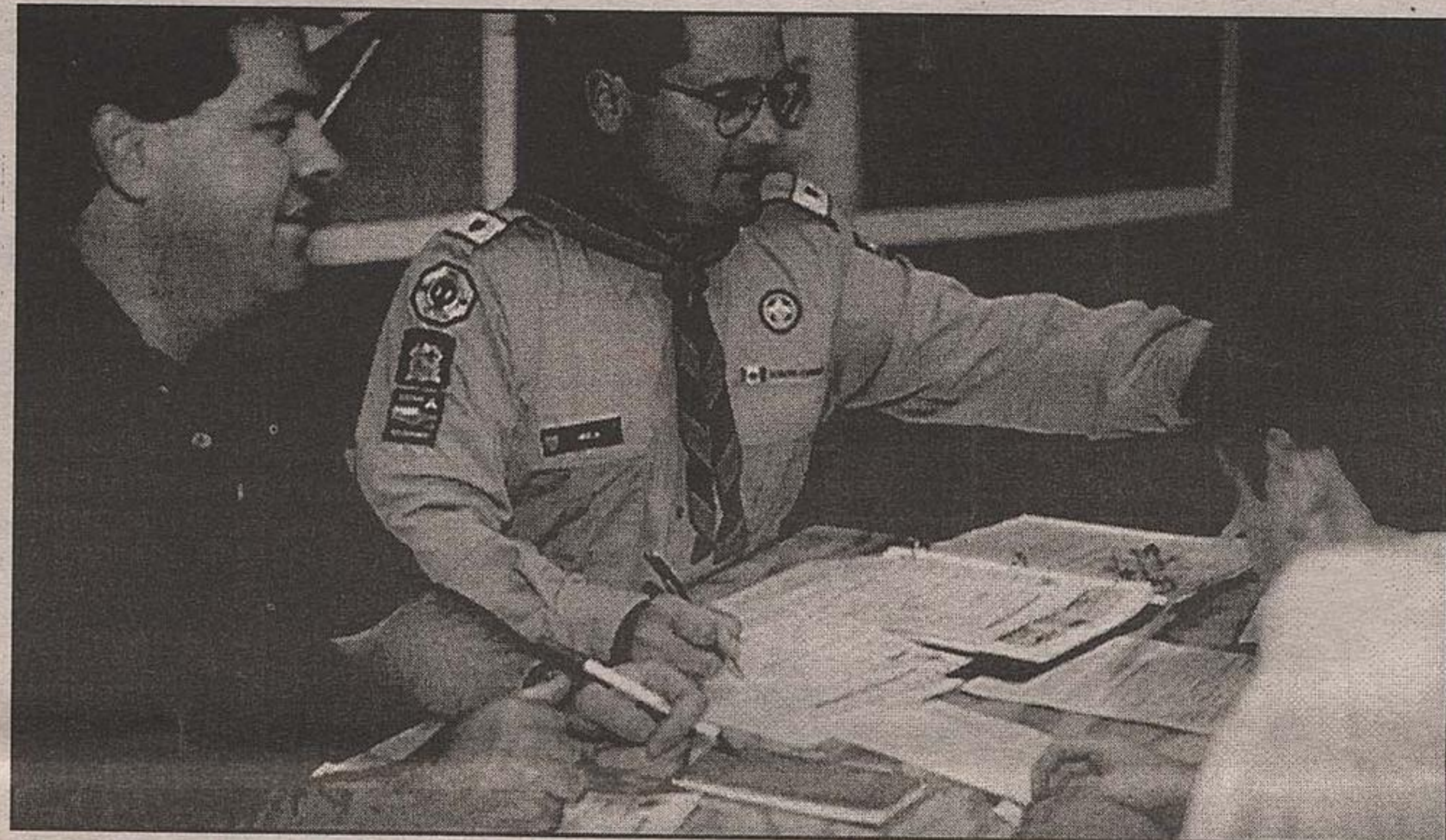
Club in Kitchener. The coach leaves at 8:15 a.m. Phone 853-5951.

Haunted Spirits sought

A ghostly gathering of ancestral spirits will be summoned once again to appear on Saturday and Sunday, October 17, 18 and 24, 25 at the Halton Region museum in Kelso Conservation Area.

Between the hours of 6:45 and 9 p.m. brave souls can go on a quest for ghostly sightings from the past during the second annual haunted homestead Spirit Search. The pre-registered

guided tours, lasting about 30 minutes, will wind throughout five acres of 19th century buildings originally built as part of the former Alexander family homestead.

The Haunted Homestead Spirit Search is organized by the Halton Region Museum, Halton Region Conservation Authority and the Milton Players Theatre Group. Admission to the event is \$10 for adults (13 and over) and \$7 for children (3 to 12 years) and includes a 30 minute guided ghost tour, food, Hallowe'en crafts and games, a pumpkin carving demonstration, and entry to Museum exhibits. Famished souls can even purchase some tasty morsels from the snack bar.
