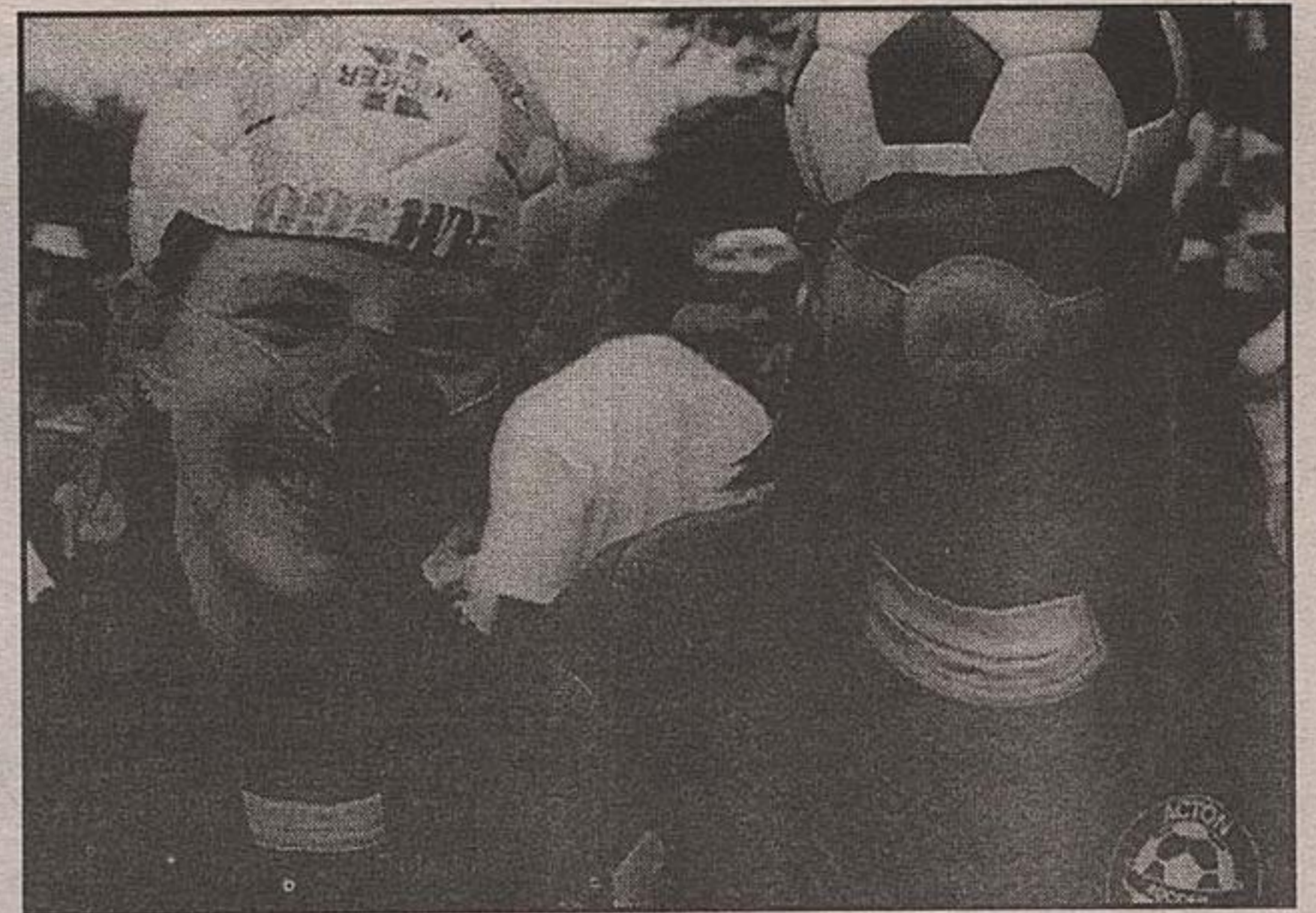

Police charge drunk drivers

A 51-year-old Acton man was charged with impaired driving after being pulled over by police early Sunday morning on Trafalgar Road near Lindsay Court in Georgetown. Police noticed a 1989 Buick being driven erratically and pulled the car over. The McDonald Boulevard man was charged with impaired and refusing a breathalyzer.

A 32-year-old Rockwood motorist was charged with having over 80 mg of alcohol in 100 ml of blood after being pulled over by Halton police on Dublin Line at 2:45 a.m. on Sunday. Police pulled the car over because a head-

light was burned out and laid the charge after talking to the driver. He appears in court Oct. 19.

Drug bust

A 27-year-old Acton man has been charged with possession of a controlled substance and possession for the purpose of trafficking following an early morning raid on a Mill Street East address on Friday. During their search police found 65 grams of hashish and small quantities of crack cocaine and marijuana. James Nicholson appears in court Nov. 19.

Silvercreek roll-over

An 11-year-old George-

town boy remains in critical condition in Sick Children's hospital following a single car accident at 5:15 p.m. on Saturday. Passenger Braden Kennedy was injured when a 1974 Jaguar XKE convertible being driven by his father, Robert Kennedy, flipped over into the ditch after losing control. Witnesses told police the Jaguar was southbound on Trafalgar at Silvercreek Drive when it pulled out to pass two cars but had to take evasive action to avoid a northbound vehicle.

The Kennedy car slid into the opposite ditch, flipped and struck a pole. The father suffered minor injuries and

was released from hospital. The investigation continues.

Shed fire

A spark from a rubbish fire ignited a garden storage shed, causing \$2,000 damage before it was extinguished by Acton fire fighters at 3:29 p.m. on Sunday. The owner of the property located on the Sixth Line, Nassagaweya between 20 and 25 Side Roads, said that he was burning garbage beside the shed when he left the fire unattended for a few minutes and returned to find the shed in flames. The homeowner managed to get all of his equipment out of the shed.

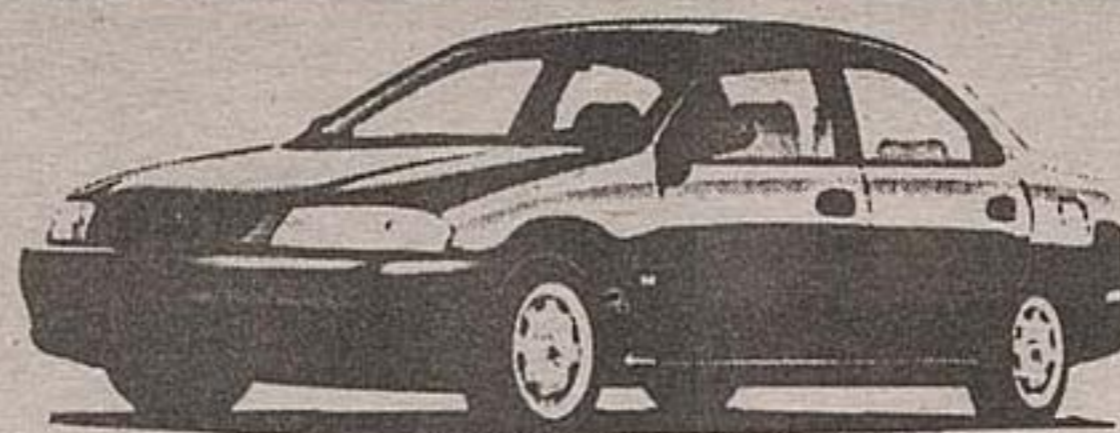

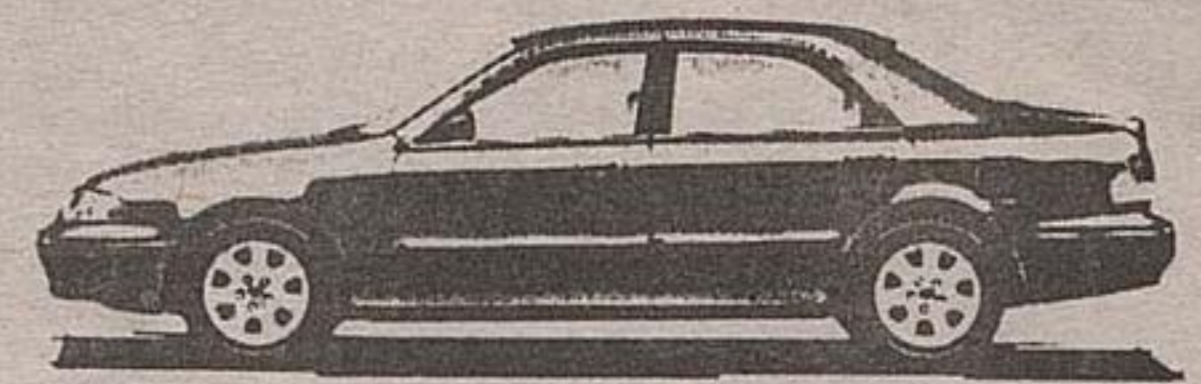

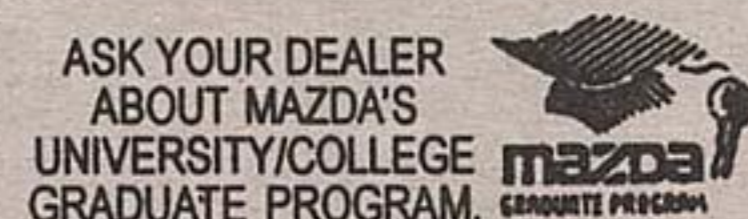
