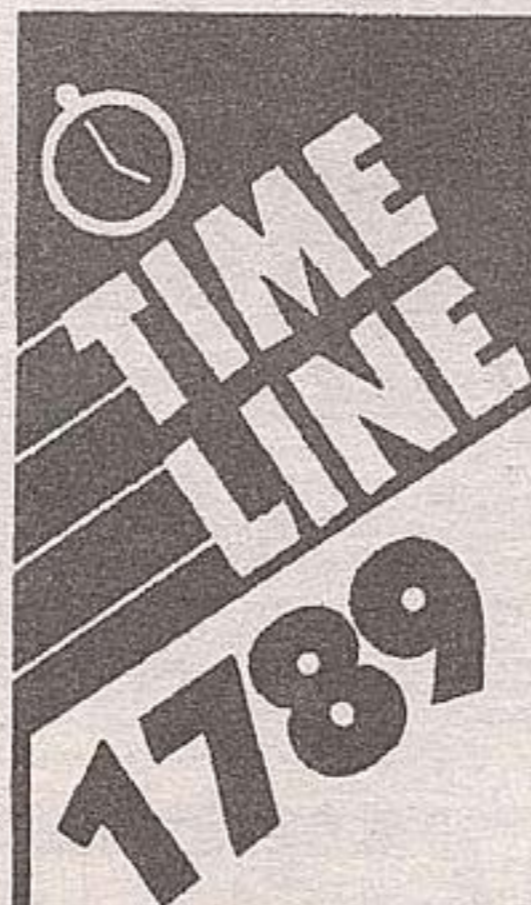
Verb Search

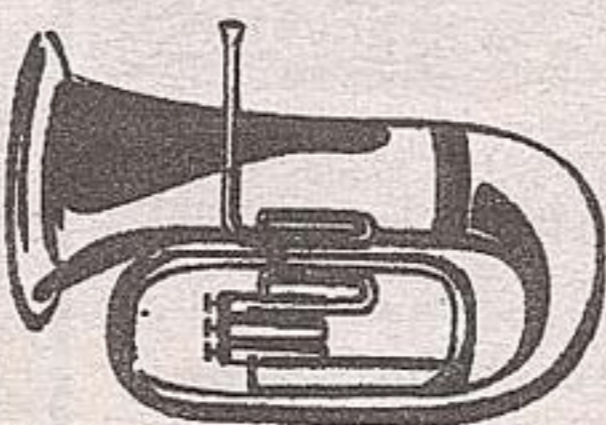

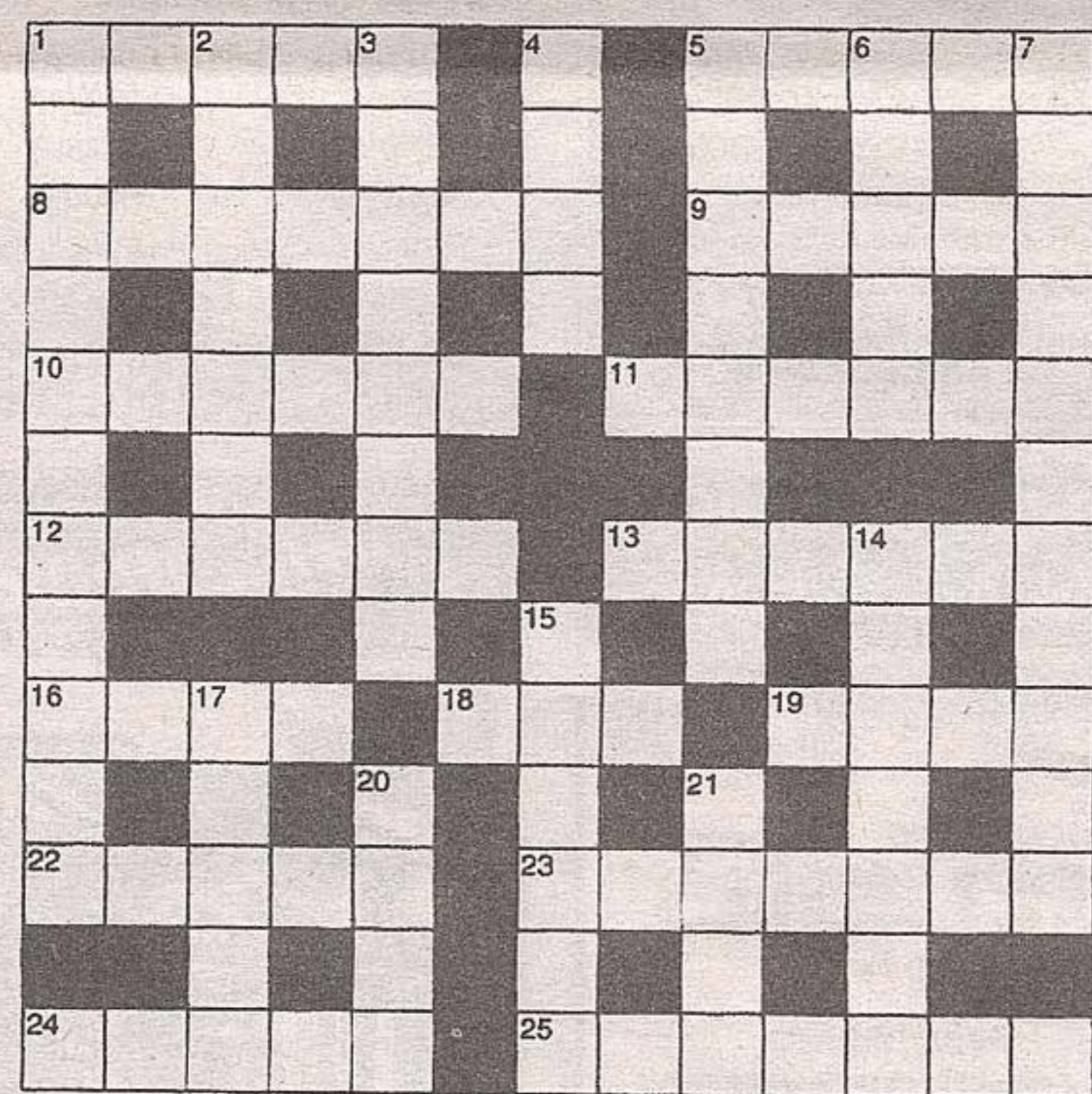
Did You Know?
