LOST YOUR WALLET?

Many times over the year I receive calls from citizens who have lost a wallet or purse. This usually includes all their identification, credit cards and bank

cards, plus cash and other items we all keep. For a

police officer to take this type of report and place

the lost or stolen items on the police computor, the

credit card numbers and date of expiry, numbers from

the identification documents are required, and usu-

ally people cannot remember these numbers. A sim-

ple solution to this is to photocoy all the documents

and to keep the photo copy in a safe place until

household valuables, such as Royal Doulton, silver-

ware, jewllery, or anything that might be subject of

an insurance claim, or for descriptive purposes for

police. Also take a photo of the serial numbers or at

least write them down, of all electronic items in your

house, such as the computer, the VCR and TV etc.

Place a copy of these photographs and lists in a safe

place and it's sometimes good to made a second copy

and put in a safe deposit box. If you need to engrave

your name on anything contact me at 853-2050 and


