## Natural Health News

#### Story on Vitamin E

Vitamin E is an antioxidant that is important in the prevention of cancer and caridovascular disease. It improves circulation, it is necessary for tissue repair, and is useful in treating premenstrual syndrome and fibocystis disease of the breast. It promotes normal blood clotting and healing, reduces scarring from some wounds, reduces blood pressure, aids in preventing cataracts and relaxes leg cramps. Vitamin E also promotes healthy skin and hair.

As an antioxidant, Vitamin E prevents cell damage by inhibiting the formation of free radicals. It retards aging and may prevent age spots as well.

Iron and Vitamin E should always be taken separately, since they hinder each other's absorption. In contrast the antioxidants Vitamin C and selenium enhance the action of Vitamin E.
