in relation to Soviet programs if they were requested to do so. If that happened, they would be paid \$85,000.

"I was satisfied the contracts were workable," Crompton says, "because I had control of them. No money would be paid to Yashin's parents unless I asked them to do something for us. I didn't hire them to do anything. They didn't bill us for anything and we didn't pay them for anything. There was nothing illegal about the contract and I resent the innuendos board members are making about it."

Crompton says when his contract was terminated after only two of its five years, the board was to buy him out. When the board recently decided to terminate those payments, Crompton's lawyer has demanded they reinstate payments and rescind their statements concerning the contract.

After a lifetime in arts Crompton is not about to stand still while his reputation is tarnished by a group of "bottom-line types" who don't understand what arts are about.
