## Dam rehab almost done

The \$136,000 rehabilitation and spruce up of the Fairy Lake dam should be complete within two weeks. Crews are now completing the installation of 35-metres of boardwalk decking before final site grading and fencing will be done.

Warren Harris, the Town's manager of Parks and Recreation, said they hope to have about \$5,000 in contingency money to help pay for land-

scaping in the spring. "They discovered the ex-

isting apron wall was in sufficient shape so we didn't have to replace that, so that was good new for the contract," Harris said, adding they might require less railing than expected, and that could also mean savings.

Kitchener-based Engineered Concrete Limited repaired and replaced the existing dam's crumbling concrete structure and sluice gate system. A chain link fence along Mill Street will be removed there will be a railing for safety which will allow people access to the edge of the lake.

The Fairly Lake dam was built around 1830 to provide power for a sawmill, then a flour mill and finally the Beardmore Tannery. Canada Packers deeded the 88-acre lake to the Town in 1990.
