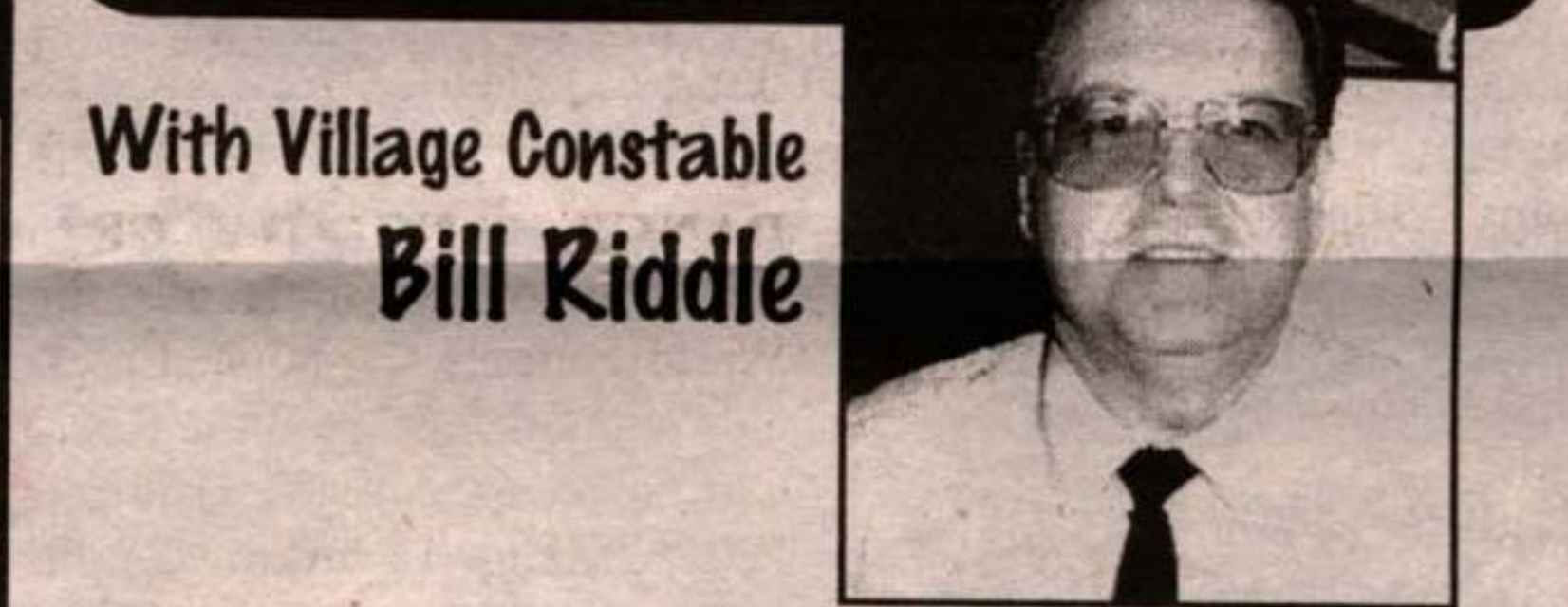

## CONSTABLE RIDDLE'S CORNER

**Winter Sports**  
Winter sports are still here, just! Here are a few skating and tobogganing safety tips.

**Skating**  
The safest place to skate in Acton, particularly now the ice and snow are melting, is at the Arena. But if some of you still wish to venture onto the ice at Fairy Lake, please be sure to check with the Town's Recreation Department that the ice is still safe. If in doubt, stay off the lake! In addition, children should always be accompanied by an adult.

Here are some other pointers which will help you to have a safe skate:

- 1 Always look first before starting off, you might be stepping out in front of a moving skater.
- 2 Try never to cross in front of another skater.
- 3 Keep some distance between you and other skaters in case someone has to stop quickly.
- 4 Do not engage in horseplay on the ice, ice is extremely hard and a fall could result in a head injury, or some other serious injury.
- 5 Young learning skaters should use a hockey type helmet, and elbow and knee pads are good also.

Find a hill and ZOOM! off you go, but be careful, what is at the bottom of the hill or partway down? Is there a tree, a large rock? These could really hurt you, or a wire fence which could cause fatal injuries. Check the hill before sliding down, is it safe?
