

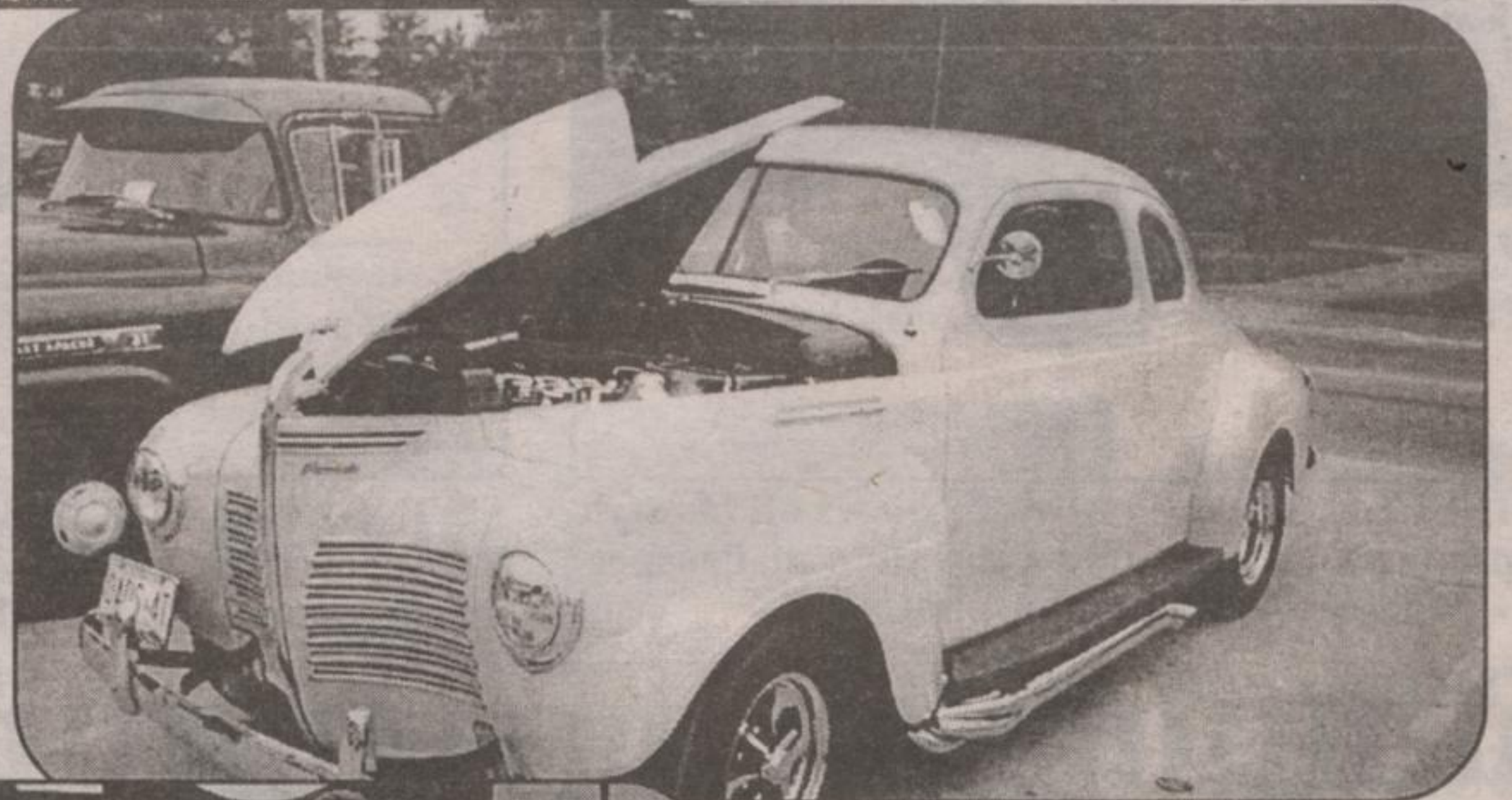

RARE BIRD: This 1977 Ford van owned by Ray and Colleen Barden looks like it was freshly painted. They bought the van after it was stored for a number of years.

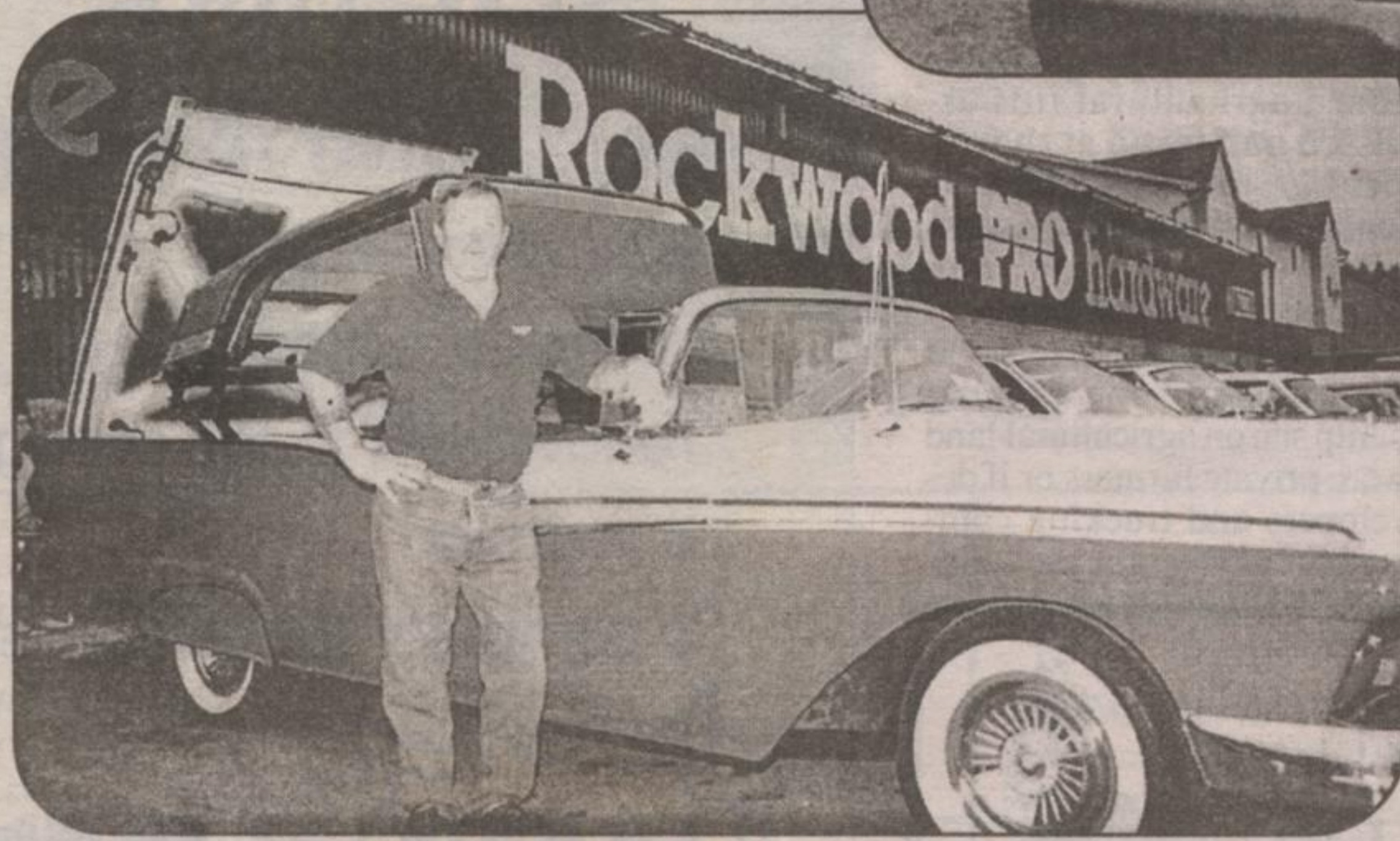
