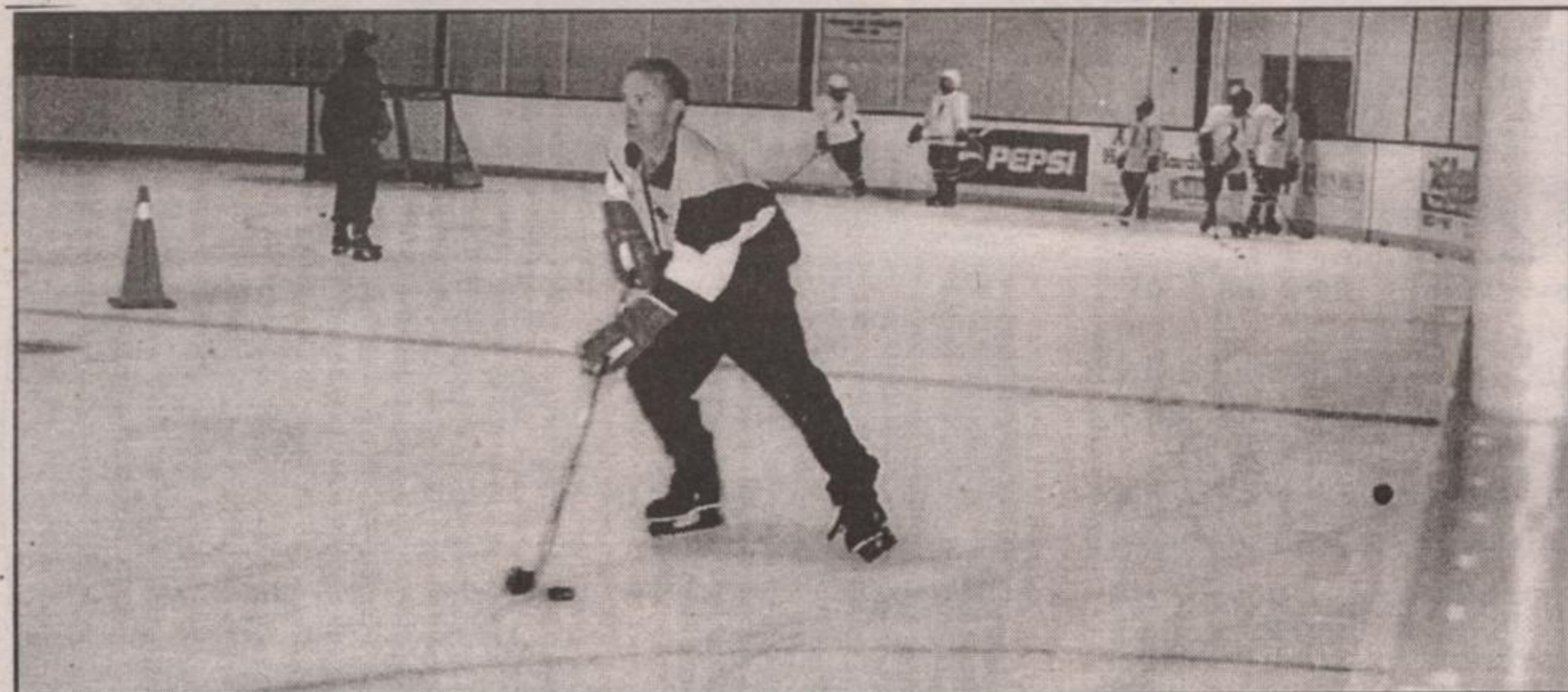

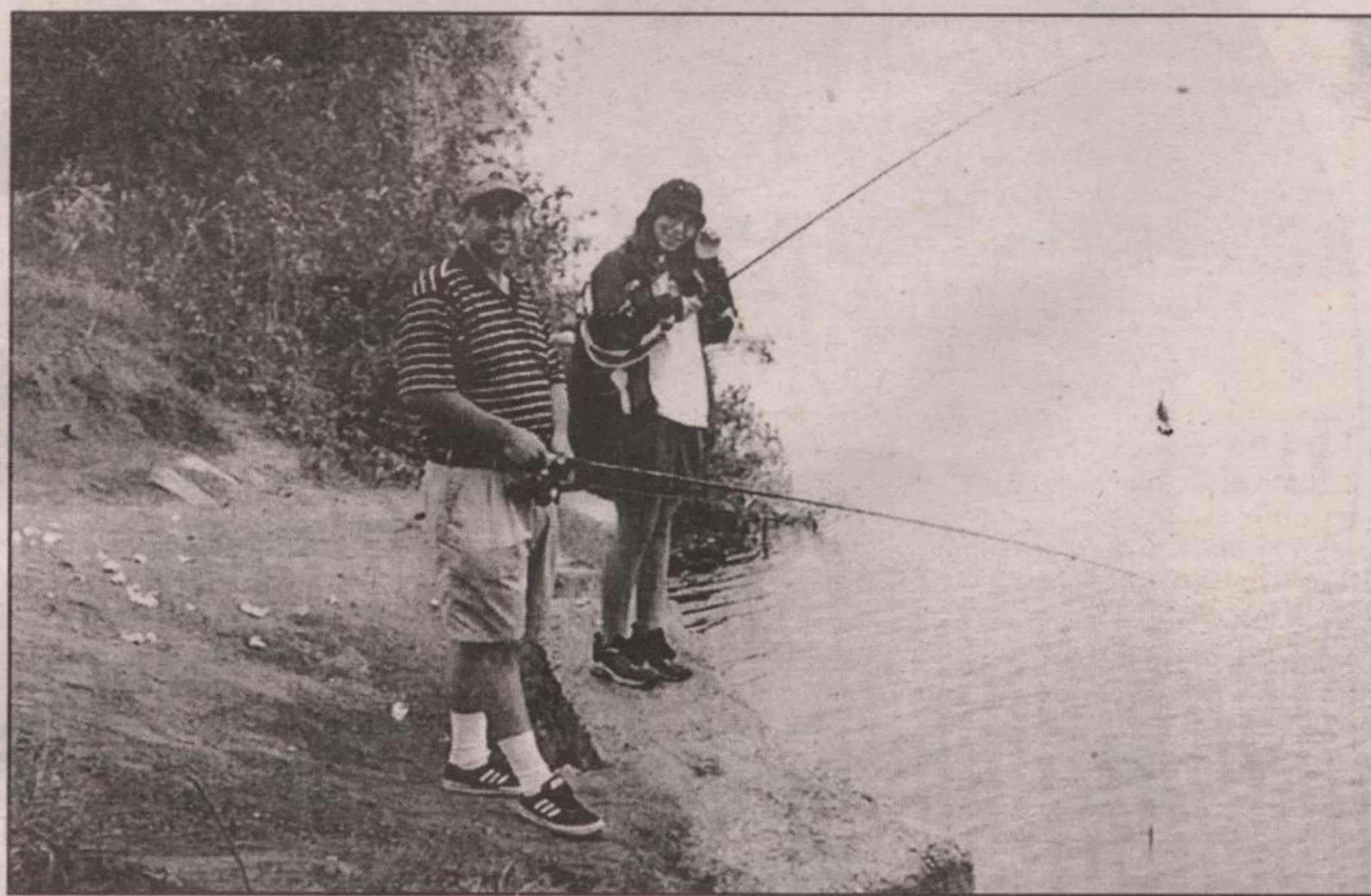

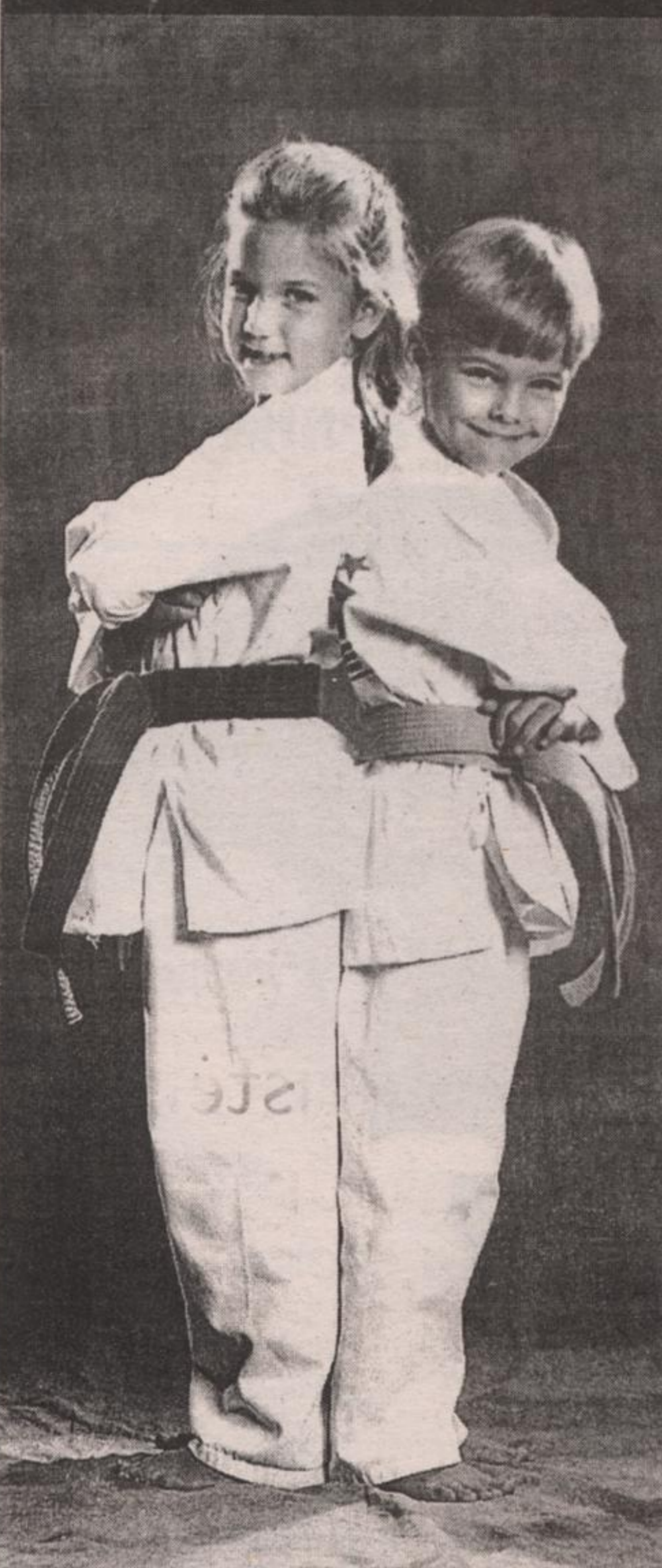
**Under-15**
