## Subway owners offer their employees cash incentive

Acton business owner Gus Galimanas and wife Maria of Subway have found a new slant on how to keep good

In these days when business operators lose staff as fast as they train them, the Galimanases have decided to offer a \$500 incentive to staff who work with them for three full years.

"This is a way to reward them for staying with us. You know, it takes a long time to train good staff and get them used to how to do things right," Galimanas says.

While their teen staff might want to use it as a scholarship toward their further education, adult staff are just as entitled and there really are no strings attached to how it is used, Galimanas says.

"They can use it for whatever they like. It isn't just for schooling although of course it could help the kids going to college or university," he says. "It's as much as a lot of their scholarships the schools offer and could be available to kids who can't get scholarships. But my adult staff are entitled to it, too, and they

might want it for anything, not just for school."

At least one staffer has already done more than two years towards her reward. Galimanas says, and will be entitled before the end of 2001 even though he only recently decided to start the system.


