## The Cleaning Man has come to town

It's fall and dedicated homemakers are busy getting the place in shape for long months indoors. Included in that cleanup is usually a big project called shampooing the rugs, upholstered furniture and even the drapes.

That's why The Cleaning Man Inc. has come to Acton. Well, sort of.

Steve Turkosz, new owner of the 18-year-old Georgetown-based business, figures there's lots of room to expand his service into Acton.

This service uses truck-mounted equipment to steam shampoo carpeting and upholstery in homes and businesses. As opposed to the portable equipment which can produce up to 250 pounds pressure, the truck-mounted type starts at 600 pounds, Turkosz explains.

He has recently purchased new equipment to ensure he

has the newest and most powerful type available for the job.

Acton native Turkosz bought out Bob Marchand and trained with him last fall before officially taking over in December.

The firm's present client base includes a number of hotels, Mohawk Raceway, assorted businesses and residences stretching from Kitchener to Whitby. Turkosz figures since both Acton and Georgetown are growing, there should be plenty of room to increase his business right here at home.

At the moment he's a one-man operation but clients can still book appointments and get their work done within a week or so.

"That's going to get a little crazy around Christmas," but for now we're not booked too far in advance. I do all the work myself just yet."

Turkosz is married and wife Tracy works with a veterinarian.
