young sons, Lavalley has been in the village for eight years. He has extensive experience in varied aspects of financial services including branch banking.

Lavalley too, feels voters need a choice and they haven't always had it in light of the acclamations and appointments to council in the past. Having always been as involved in his community as his career would permit, he offers reason, rational decision making and community responsiveness to council.

He sees this as an important stage for council between the expansion into Guelph/Eramosa and the number of issues coming up, such as

completion of the township's 10-year strategic plan.

While the firehall was the catalyst for his decision to seek election now, his concern really is more with the way council handles communications, and whether due diligence is exercised in making its decisions. He questions, for instance, whether a new fire hall is actually needed, or whether the existing one can be made to fill the requirements. After that comes the issue of whether a proper location has been chosen if the hall is really needed.

He was also concerned with an impression that council felt its duty to its firefighters preceded its duty to its constituents.

be a problem. The developers will pay just less than half of the total upgrades and Regional Council will be asked to approve the balance in the rate supported capital budget in mid-January.

Hope said before any of the treatment plant upgrades can be made, a study must be completed of the feasibility of constructing a second well at Prospect Park to cover a shortfall in what is called firm capacity - the amount of water available with the largest well out of service.


If all the developers meet their requirements and Halton council approves it's share of the upgrade costs, Hope said the Region could call tenders for the work early next year.

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A shed roof, wood siding and stone accents highlight the exterior of this craftsman-style basement-entry design. The front-window overhangs provide practical protection from summer sun as well as deflecting the rain.

On the lower level, the laundry room has direct access from the double garage, providing double duty as a mud room. The expansive unfinished basement includes roughed-in plumbing for a three-piece bathroom, ready for completion of the area as additional sleeping or recreational space when required. Upstairs, the kitchen, dining area and living room stretch across the full width of the house to provide a great-room concept that is both practical and enjoyable for today's families.  
The large kitchen has corner sinks under right-angled windows and a generous amount of counter space. A central island expands the work area and a pantry provides plenty of storage room. Sliding glass doors from the dining area open to a good-sized sun deck that is sure to be well-used for outdoor eating and entertaining during the summertime.  
The large living area has a gas fireplace and a windowsill that adds character and charm to the room.  
The sleeping area at the rear of the house includes the master suite, privately situated at one end with a three-piece en suite bathroom and a good-sized walk-in closet. Two secondary bedrooms share a three-piece bathroom with fitted shelves. A linen cupboard is conveniently located between the two bedrooms.  
The house is 40 feet wide and 40 feet, 6 inches deep with 1,202 square feet of living space and an unfinished basement.

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# Speedside Festival international fest

The Speedside Festival, which runs this week from October 19 to 22 at Ebenezer United Church on the Guelph Line, is one of Canada's premiere fall musical events. This year the festival features nine prominent artists from North America and Europe including Martin Beaver, originally from Hamilton and now professor of violin at the prestigious Peabody Conservatory in Baltimore. He is joined by string-players Paul Rosenthal, a New Yorker now resident in Juneau, Alaska; David Harding, a Georgetown native and now professor of viola at UBC in Vancouver; Bryan Epperson, principal cellist of the Canadian and Santa Fe Opera Orchestras who hails from Salt

Lake City, Utah. Others include Simon Wynberg, the festival's artistic director and guitarist who was born in Edinburgh and is now resident in Toronto; Virginian, Linda Maguire, who enjoys an international opera and concert career, will be partnered by the German pianist Thomas Schubert (a descendant of the composer Franz Schubert). Two more pianists complete the line-up; Phillip Bush, professor at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, and Torontonian Dianne Werner, who teaches at Toronto's Royal Conservatory of Music.
