Split level design

A main-floor master suite is a design that appeals to many homeowners and this split-level plan provides this option while giving the sleeping quarters plenty of privacy.

A few steps away from the kitchen, tucked away at the side of the house, the master suite is separated from the central living area on the main floor.

At the entrance to the house, a covered veranda offers an inviting welcome to the front door and into the rectangular foyer, which is open to formal living

room on the right.

The dining room adjoins the living room and combines to make a large area that will be ideal for entertaining friends and family. A sloping ceiling adds design interest in the dining room, and space has been allowed for a useful buffet.

A sliding door provides easy access to the family room and also closes off this area when required. The family room, kitchen and breakfast room combine in a spacious, open area that is sure to be appreciated for all day-to-day activities. The family room also has a sloping ceiling, as well as a gas fireplace for cosy gatherings during the cooler months. The kitchen has a central island, a walk-in pantry and plenty of counter space for easy prepara-

tion of meals. A door from the breakfast room opens on to the covered deck at the rear.

A laundry room, powder room and coat cupboard complete the layout on this level.

Stairs from the family room lead to the upper sleeping area, where bedrooms 2 and 3 share a three-piece bathroom.

The front bedroom has an attractive bay window with a window seat - the perfect spot to curl up with a book.

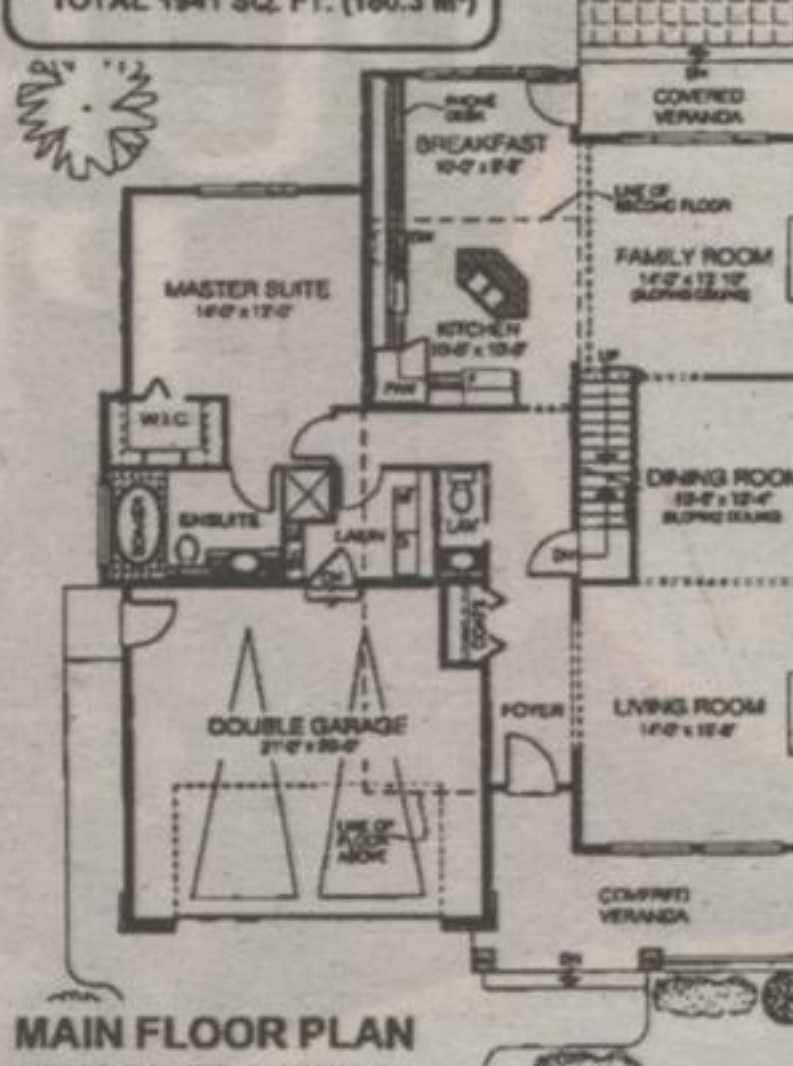
The double garage has a side door as well as access to the house through the laundry room.

Pillars and stone accents enhance the exterior of this 1-1/2 storey plan and the design includes an unfinished basement.

The house is 42 feet wide and 53 feet, 10 inches deep with 1941 sq. ft. of living space.

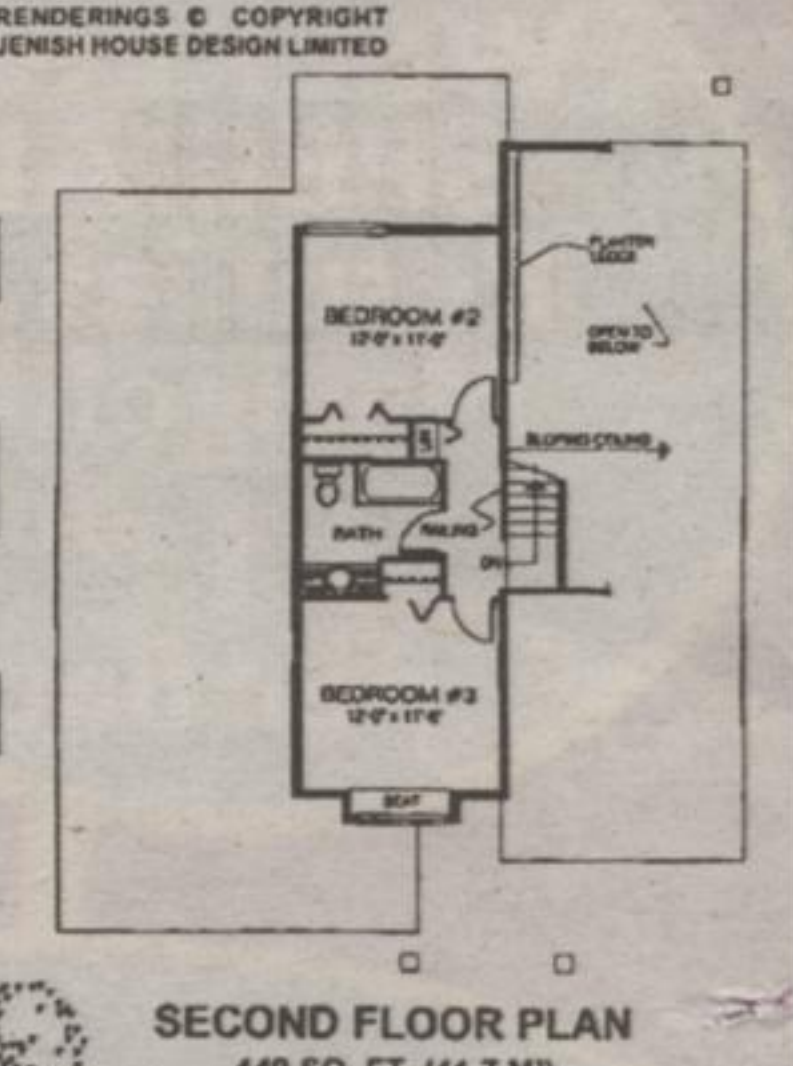
