C.	Leathertown Festival (Acton) Sunday, August 12, 2001 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	Mill Street East between Main Street and Eastern Avenue, and Fellows Street from Mill Street East to Church Street East.

The Council Meeting will commence at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, July 9th, 2001 in the Council Chambers, Civic Centre, 1 Halton Hills Drive. At this meeting, Council will hear, in person, any person who claims to be prejudicially affected by the said by-law and who applies to the Town Clerk at 873-2601 x 2331, before the Council Meeting.



I ask all pet owners to please provide plenty of fresh water and protection from the sun for all your pets.


Do not take family pets in the car, even for a short ride, in hot weather.




