Halton Hills Bulldogs mine silver at Mimico tourney

In the second game the Bulldogs faced the Orangeville Northmen. Jordan Kuenzig opened the scoring on the powerplay. The game was tied after 1 period and after two periods the Bulldogs were down 2-1. Orangeville added 3 more goals to win 5-1. The loss placed the Bulldogs in the silver medal

game.

In the silver game, the Bulldogs faced Toronto Beaches, the same team that beat them in the Shelburne tournament. There was no scoring the first period and none until middle of the second. Cameron Decourcy opened the scoring on a pass from Klein. Kuenzig scored his first goal of four in

the game unassisted, to give the Bulldogs a 2-0 lead.

After two periods the game was tied at two. In the third period Rovere added a goal and an assist, Terry added a goal and Kuenzig added 3 more goals to lift the Ramrock Electric Bulldogs to a 7-3 win and the silver medal.
