21st Terry Fox Run raises over \$27,500

The horror of the World Trade Centre tragedy made participants in last Sunday's Terry Fox Run in Acton more somber, and possibly more generous.

This year's run opened on the track behind Acton High School with a moment's silence and Scripture readings for the victims and survivors of the terrorist attacks.

One hundred and fifty participants pledged \$27,500 and organizer Jon Hurst hopes, like last year, they will collect more for cancer research than was pledged.

"Last year was our best year ever and it looks like we've at least equalled it," Acton run committee member Jon Hurst said on Sunday.

"Our hope is that there may

be some extra coming in again and maybe we'll get to that magic \$29,000 again," he said, adding 30 volunteers helped make the event a success.

The 21 Acton Terry Fox Runs to date have raised almost \$435,000 for cancer research.

On September 13, a Terry Fox assembly was held at Acton High school. Adam Green, a Terry Fox team member from the Terry Fox Foundation told the students about his personal battle and triumph over cancer.

A portrait of Terry Fox was presented to principal Greg MacPherson on behalf of the Foundation and the Acton run committee to thank the high school for hosting the event for the past 20 years.


