
Events that have been shuffled include: Light Horse Show to Sunday; Pony Shows to Saturday; Gentle Ben's Pet Show to Saturday morning.

Our theme this year is the "Pumpkin," and there'll be many entertaining and interesting uses of the theme at this year's fair, Wendy says.


