Erin Fall Fair this weekend

It's Thanksgiving weekend and time for the annual Erin Fall Fair - the 151<sup>st</sup> edition of an event popularly called "The Little Royal." The two events are synonymous.

"Our exhibitions continually compete with world class livestock, commodities and rural crafts, which has provided our fair with the reputation of being Ontario's Pre-

view to the Royal," Erin Agricultural Society president Mark Reilly proudly points out.

In his message to fair goers Reilly encourages them to experience every aspect of the Fair.

"In order to encourage weekend attendance, we have kept the price of the weekend pass at an exceptional price.

From the opening of our fair Friday evening to the final hour, we are proud to provide exceptional value for your cost of admission," Reilly says.

"We have added to and shuffled our weekend events this year in an ongoing effort to improve our fair. New events and events of note include: the OPP Golden Helmets and Baby Show on Saturday afternoon; the Kids Pedal Pull will run qualifying heats each day with the final on Monday on the track; and George Fox will be showcased on Monday afternoon.

Events that have been shuffled include: Light Horse Show to Sunday; Pony Shows to Saturday; Gentle Ben's Pet Show to Saturday morning."

Wendy McDougall, Homecraft president, echoes president Reilly's thoughts. "Our rural roots are important to the members of the Erin Agricultural Society. We try to present an exciting new fair every year by blending the traditional with the new.

Our theme this year is the "Pumpkin," and there'll be many entertaining and interesting uses of the theme at this year's fair, Wendy says.

Erin Fair celebrated its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary last year when the exhibit hall was decorated with the theme, "Down Memory Lane," which fairgoers found to be "fabulous." The Antique Corner and the parade were also highlights of that weekend and organizers are predicting they'll be equally pleased with this year's presentation.

Hall exhibits open on Friday, October 5 at 7:00 p.m. and all weekend long through Saturday, Sunday and Monday October 6, 7 and 8 the fair goes on.

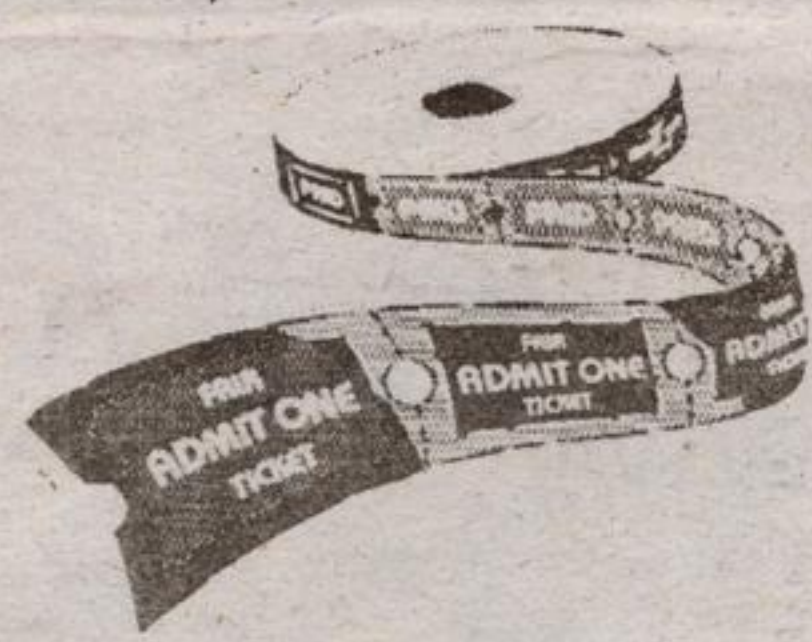
