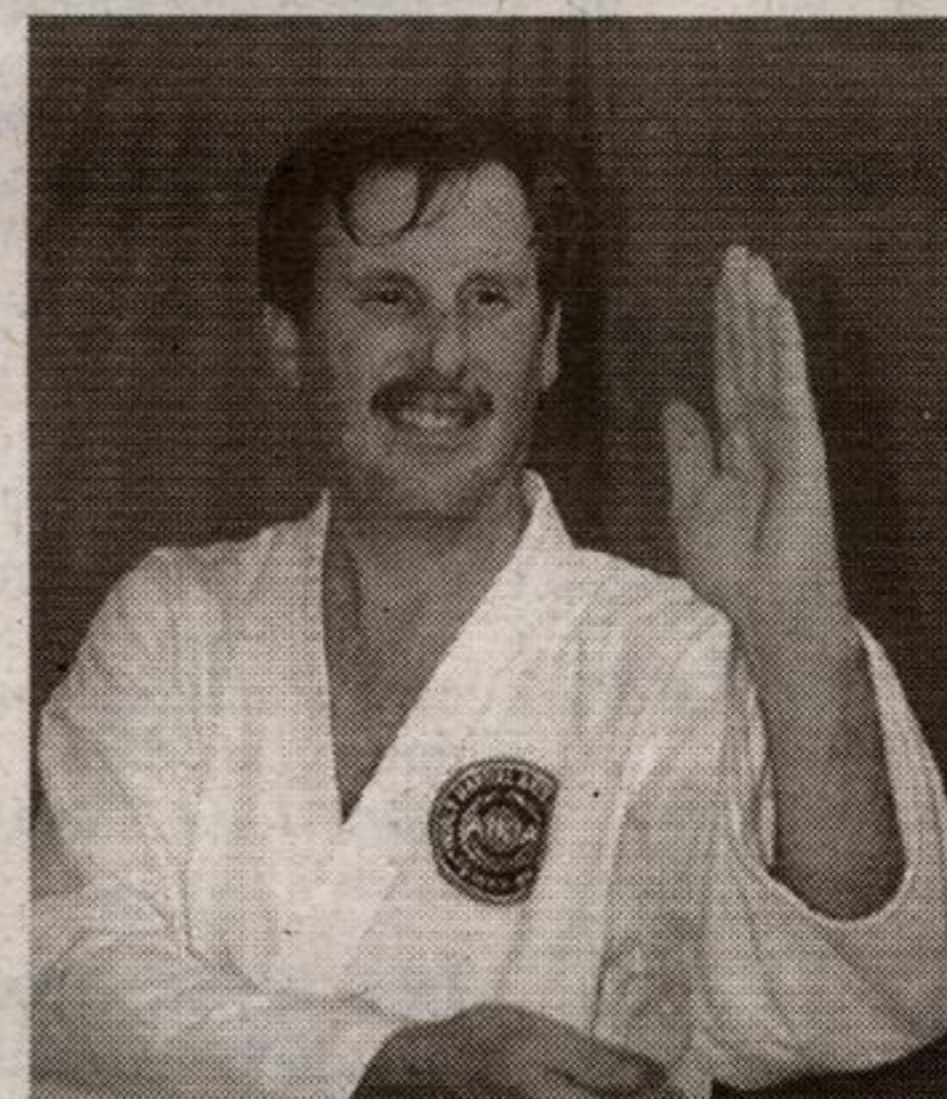
The Minors were back on their game, Tuesday, October 16 in Acton, taking control in the first period and never looking back, downing Elora
