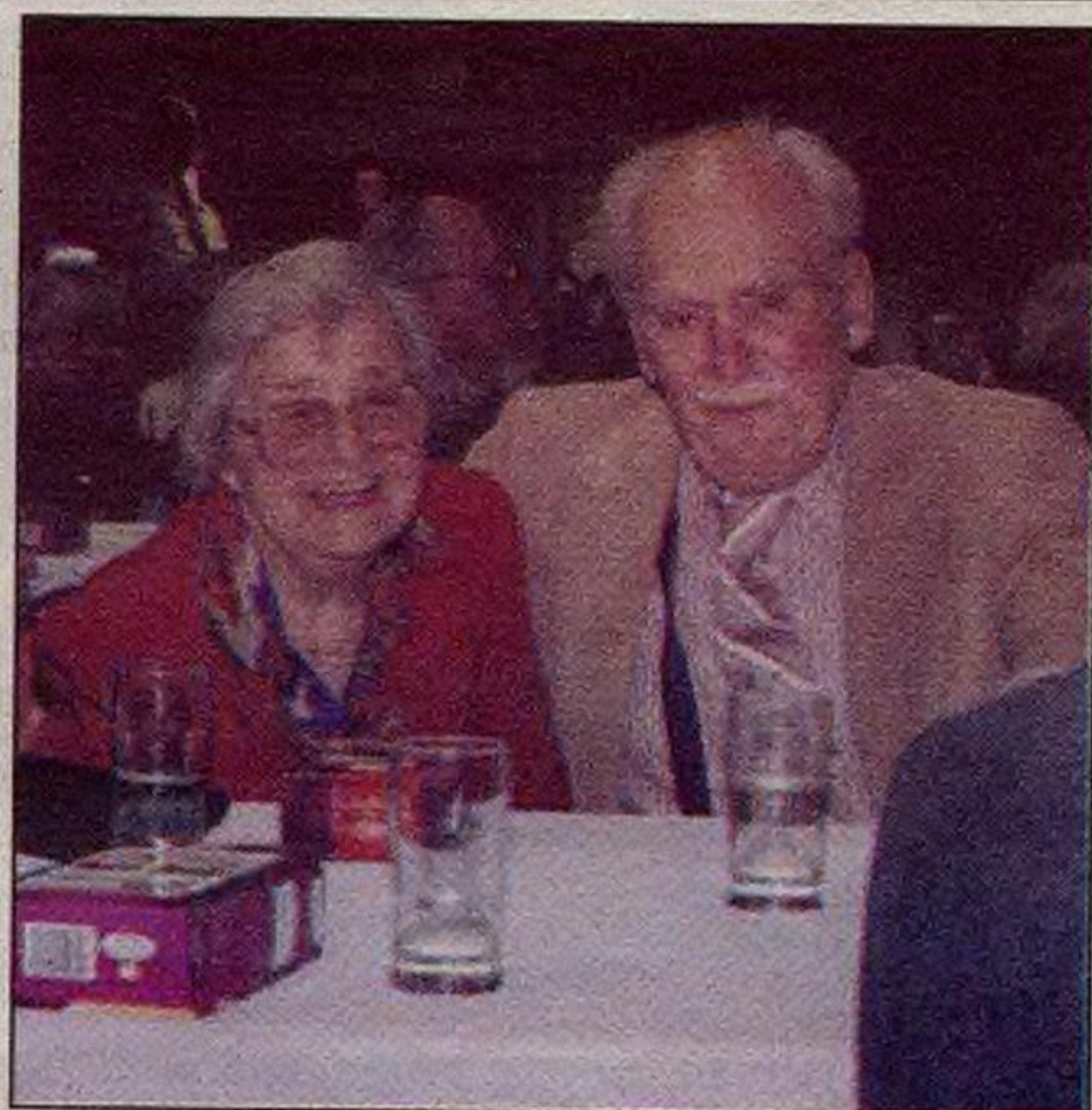

Entertainment was provided by the 45 member Acton Citizens' Band under the baton of Bandmaster Dr.

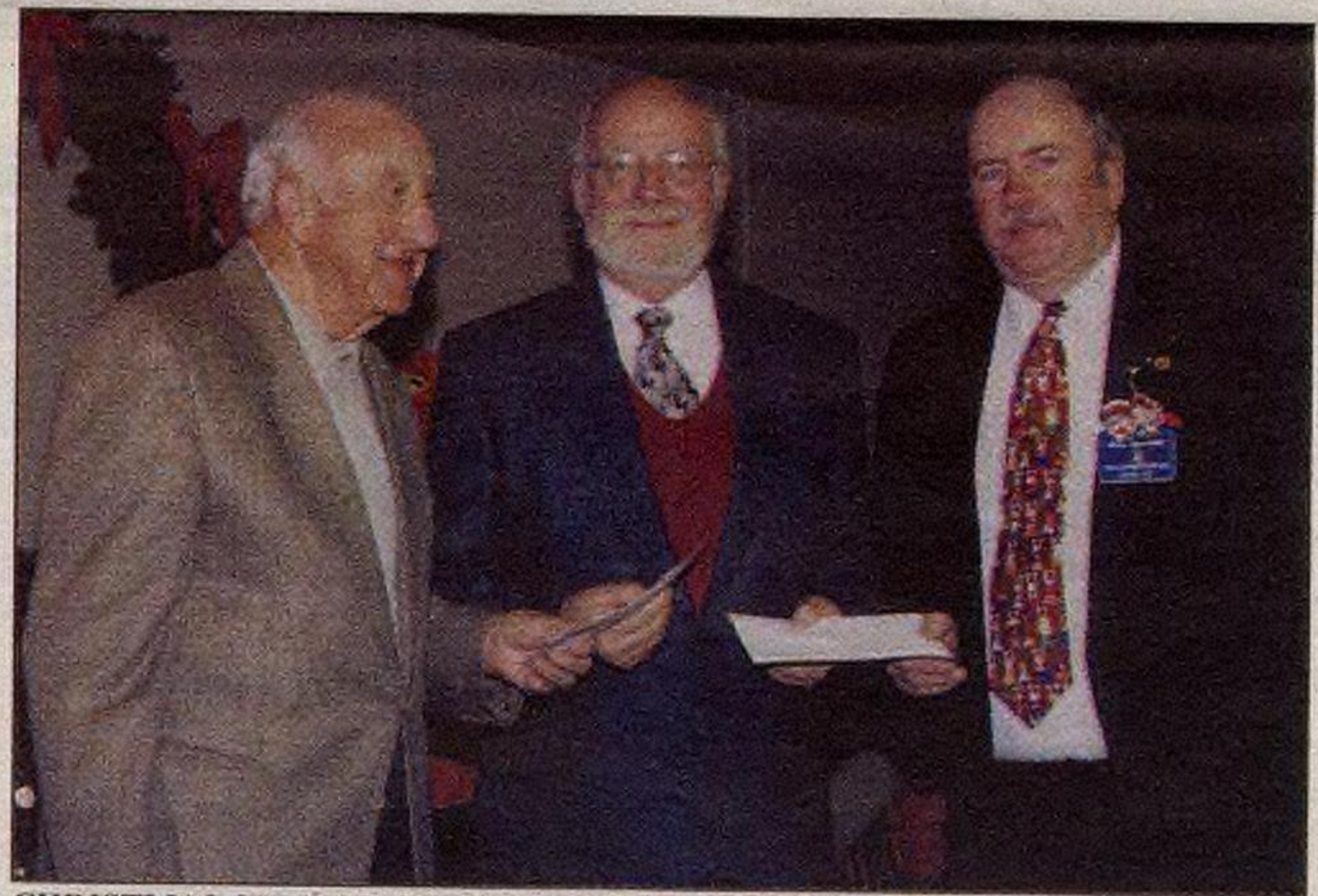
