Halton Regional Police Service is commencing its annual Festive RIDE (Reduce Impaired Driving Everywhere) program this week to ensure a safe holiday season throughout Halton Region.

Teams of officers will be out in full force with a message of safe, sober driving.

'Passport to RIDE' coupon books will be distributed at the spot checks. The Passports demonstrate the support of corporate sponsors who have recognized the importance of sober driving. This message is passed to the public in the form of discount coupons that can be redeemed at participating organizations. The Passport to Ride program has helped raise \$925,000 for the youth of Variety Village.

This year, members of MADD (Mothers Against Drunk Driving) will be joining police officers to help reinforce the message of eliminating drinking and driving in our community. Halton Regional Police Service and MADD Halton have partnered for several years to educate and enhance awareness concerning the severe consequences associated with impaired driving.
