





that this Halton community would benefit the most. This was to be the precursor to a Region-wide program. Instead, it was terminated, or in the language used, "deferred".

As a result, Halton is now many years behind in water conservation, and in comparison to Waterloo Region. And as I understand it, the region is having problems recruiting citizens to serve on the committee - this should not be surprising as I had one citizen ex-member tell me that the region wasted his time and capabilities.

Perhaps with the citizens of Georgetown making this an issue, the region can dust off its deferral decision and reverse it. The research has been done, the Rose Technology plan is still relatively fresh, and there doesn't seem to be any obstacle except a decision of Council to move ahead. I hope that you do so.

I am more than willing to discuss this with you further at any time.
