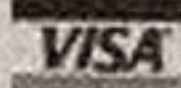

Ontario OPP statistics show 98,110 vehicles are stopped in RIDE program

Ontario Provincial Police released statistics for the fifth week of the 2001-2002 Festive Season RIDE for all OPP jurisdictions in Ontario. They showed 98,110 vehicles were stopped at roadside checkpoints, 183 12-hour suspensions were issued and 80 persons were charged with Criminal Code alcohol related offences.

Officers issued 79 Administrative Drivers Licence Suspensions immediately suspending driving privileges for 90 days.

A total of 606,600 vehicles were checked at roadside checkpoints compared to 475,535 during the same period in 2000, and 552 persons were charged with alcohol-related Criminal Code driving offences during the 2001/2002 campaign. Over the same period in 1999/2000, 460 persons were charged with alcohol-related driving charges under the Criminal Code.

Police noted 532 persons were issued with the Administrative Drivers Licence suspension and were immediately suspended from driving for 90 days. Also, 1,222 persons were issued 12-hour suspensions, up from the 1999/2000 total of 890.

During the RIDE campaign, injury collisions were reduced by 14% on OPP patrolled highways. Unfortunately, alcohol related collisions still claimed the lives of 12 people during the five-week event.

Police remind motorists that the RIDE program will continue throughout the year and is not limited to holidays and long weekends. The program and other drinking and driving countermeasures are core functions of the Ontario Provincial Police and continue to be a priority. RIDE checkpoints could be set up at any place and at any time throughout the year.
