Acton had the best of the play from then on, but did not score another until a minute into the third, then Roger Kirkness fired a shot into the top corner, again assisted by Jesse Spurrell. Three minutes later Jesse Spurrell stole the puck in the neutral zone and sent Mitchell Brake


in on a breakaway. Brake's shot along the ice beat the Agincourt goalie to give Acton a 3-0 lead.

It was Brake's second goal of the season to go with his 14 assists. The three assists for Spurrell give him a team-leading 22, of which 11 were recorded in the last seven games. Kirkness' two goals give him 10 in his last six games.

Agincourt finally broke through with just under five minutes left in the game, scoring to make it 3-1 Acton. The goal seemed to energize the Canadians, as they applied tremendous pressure on goalie Zachary Payne, who played

the full game in net for Acton. Payne made numerous good saves to keep the Canadians at bay, as the play stayed in the Acton end. Agincourt finally scored from a scramble in front of the net with only 48 seconds left, leaving the Tanners clinging to a 3-2 lead. Unfortunately Agincourt kept the pressure up, and sneaked a puck into the net with only 11 seconds to tie the game 3-3.


Roger Kirkness was awarded a Milton Winterhawks medal for his two goals. The tournament continues with the next game on Saturday.
