The OPP are encouraging home owners to only

deal with reputable business persons when having work done on their homes. It is always wise to check with your local business association or the Better Business Bureau.

OPP suggest that seniors and those not familiar with contractual issues have a trusted family member or friend review every contract before signing. For large repairs or improvements police always suggest that purchasers obtain at least two or three different quotes from a reliable source.
