submissions from local and GTA artists including pottery, painting, jewelry and woodworking.


"Hopefully, there will be a little arts and culture area - one street - it should be interesting," Osborn said.

Apartment Security

I am sure that many readers live in apartment buildings and senior residences, here in Acton.

Just like homeowners, there are many important guidelines that you should follow to protect yourself and your apartment from intrud-

One of the most important mistakes, is allowing an unknown person into an apartment building. Do you really want a stranger wandering around inside you apartment building? When your buzzer sounds, do not release the lobby door until proper identification is made. If you are not sure about someone's identification, refer them to the superintendent.

- · Do not identify yourself as female on the call board.
- Use only your first initial with your last name. (this applies to the local phone book too.)
- Ensure your apartment door is equipped with a quality deadbolt lock, chain and a wideangle peephole. Be sure you know who is at your door, before opening it.

When arriving home or leaving the apartment, be aware of your surroundings. Observe for suspicious people or vehicles in the area. Make sure you lock your vehicle doors. Make the apartment superintendent aware of any suspicious behaviour.

third and fourth in two earlier races this season.

"We kind of thought we had a good horse, but you never know until you run him. It came together in the last couple of months. It's the biggest race of his career, and now he's the champion," Molarino said, adding anyone can buy a winner, but to breed one, is something "extra special."

Another Molarino horse, Kristy Krunch, ran third in the 1996 Queen's Plate.

Molarino Stable farm manager Jo-Anne Martin delivered T J's Lucky Moon, a "tiny" colt three years ago at the Acton farm, the third foal, the only one with straight legs, from the brood mare, who won 10 races for


Molarino.

"The stallion Tejabo, who also stood outside Acton where we bred him, was called T J. This colt was pretty lucky to be born with straight legs and was born under a full moon," Martin said, explaining his name.

Martin said T J's Lucky Moon was a "kicker and striker with a little mean streak," who was gelded after he injured several people at the track, including a groom who was kicked in the stomach.

Asked if T J's Lucky Moon will race in the Prince of Wales Stake on July 21 at Woodbine, Molarino said that's up to the trainers, but if he doesn't race "he gets what he wants for the rest of his life" – a champion pet.


