## Sewage plant upgrades on schedule

Multi-million dollar upgrades to the Region's Third Line wastewater treatment plant - work that will allow Acton to grow to 10,000 people – are on schedule and on budget.

Bruce Kitchen, Halton's director of engineering services, said the "guts" of the project – the tanks and

concrete at the plant are completed and the plumbing and wiring will be ready by mid-November.

As one former Halton chairman put it, "development in Acton is tied to its toilets". Growth in town was stalled for decades until the developers and municipal officials could agree on who would pay how much of the \$7.2-million upgrades that would allow additional sewage from new homes and businesses to be treated with the effluent being pumped into Black Creek, a cold water fishery.

Kitchen said once the work was completed, all of the instrumentation and computer controls in the plant must be tested before "it goes live."

While the plant upgrades were designed to handle sewage from 10,000, once it's up and running, they'll try to "optimize" operations and "see how far we






7:30pm. They had a great time last year and hope to see everyone back again. Newcomers are always welcome, no experience is necessary. If you are looking for an evening out, come on down.
