

# Both Acton beaches are unsafe

Test done on Tuesday, August 27 show both Fairy Lake beaches in Acton are unsafe for swimming. Previously only the Boathouse Beach was deemed unsafe while old beach in Prospect Park was approved.

Halton Health Department

regularly tests beaches throughout Halton and the latest tests showed only one beach in Halton - Kelso Conservation Area in Milton - is safe for swimming. High bacterial levels in both Acton beaches, in Burlington Bronte Park and

Coronation Park in Oakville were deemed unfit for bathing.


Put your name on a ballot each day you visit and you will be eligible to win prizes. Draws will take place on Friday, September 13 at 3:00pm.
