## Halton Board looks for classroom tutors

Halton District School Board, in partnership with the Ministry of Education, is offering post secondary students an opportunity to work as part-time Classroom Tutors in Halton's elementary and secondary schools.

To be eligible, candidates must be presently enrolled in mathematics, science, applied science and technology programs in Ontario colleges and universities.

The tutoring will be a minimum eight hours per week required for 20 weeks. (November 1, 2002 to April 28, 2003). An honourarium of \$2,000 (paid in 2 instalments) will be paid to the tutors.
