Rockmosa Community Centre was the site for the Ontario Dog Groomers' Association fall show on Sunday.

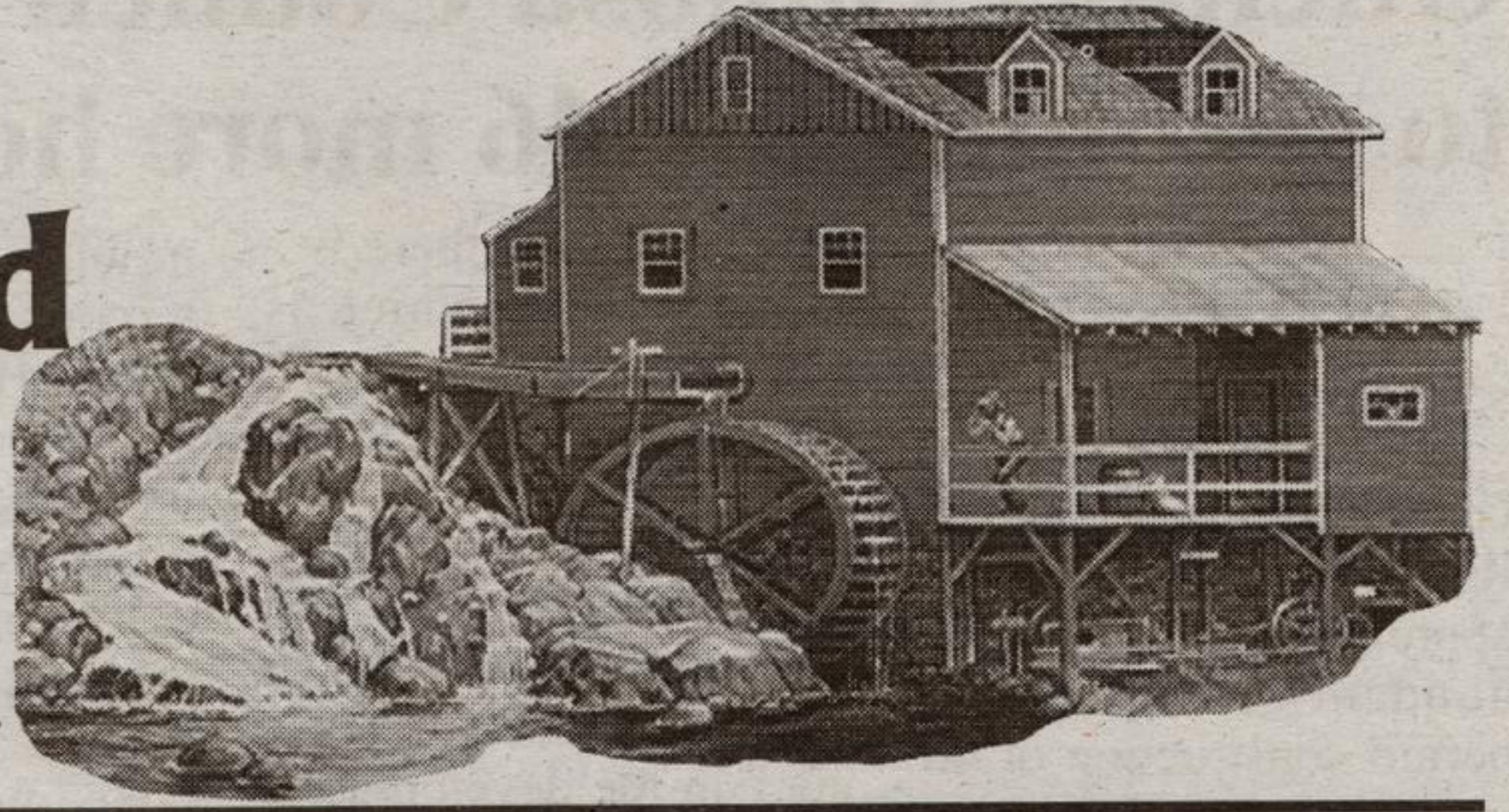

## Council agrees to rezone strip in Rockwood Ridge

Guelph/Eramosa council has agreed to the rezoning of a strip of land in Rockwood Ridge subdivision in order to enlarge a residential lot.

The 20-foot strip of land adjacent to a former model home on Highway 7 was zoned neighbourhood commercial with a holding designation. When the model home was sold, developer's representative Jeremy Grant told council, they agreed to include the extra land for the purchaser. However, it was zoned commercial, not residential. The application would simply give it

proper zoning to conform to its use for a garage and driveway.

The strip is adjacent to the site of the proposed Tim Horton outlet, for which earlier this month council rejected an application to remove a holding designation.

Coun. Doug Breen wanted to know how quickly the change would happen. When he was assured the change is instantaneous, and no opportunity exists to somehow lift the holding designation from the adjacent Horton site, he agreed to support the rezoning.

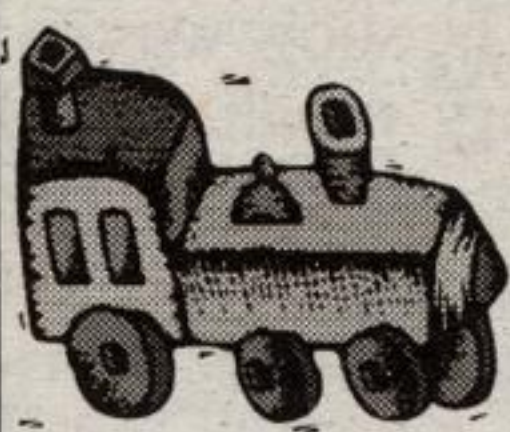
